RACE 1: WEATHERBYS GLOBAL STALLIONS APP HANDICAP

Orazio Wallop Katey Kontent

A comfortable winner of this contest last year off 11lb lower, ORAZIO could not have asked for a better prep towards his defence than running a highly creditable third in the Listed Cammidge Trophy last month. William Buick renews the partnership and they could have too much for Ayr Gold Cup winner Significantly and handicap debutant Wallop, who is very interesting pitched in here on just his fifth career outing. Unlucky on a couple of occasions last season, Katey Kontent is another to note, along with Chipstead and Great Ambassador.

- WOBWOBWOB Winner of five races from 6f to 7f on ground varying from good to soft. Beaten 9l behind Knebworth at 9-1 when 12th of 14 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 6f (soft) last month.
- 14 WOVEN He has won three times from 6f to 7f on ground varying from good to soft. Beaten a short head by Knebworth when second of 14 at 11-2 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 6f (soft) last month.
- 15 JUST A SPARK Winner of seven races from 5f to 6f on good to soft ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 1l by Cloud Cover when second of 9 at 8-1 on her latest outing at Newcastle over 7f last month.

RACE 2: BET365 FEILDEN STAKES (LISTED)

El Cordobes Narkez Ambiente Friendly

Following a similar path to Highland Avenue, who won this race for Charlie Appleby in 2021, EL CORDOBES can go some way to repaying his monumental price tag by following up a comfortable success at Kempton. The extra furlong should suit, and it may be French raider Narkez who gives him most to think about following a taking performance on heavy ground at Saint Cloud on his return. Ambiente Friendly and Gasper De Lemos arrive on the back of creditable efforts in Group races here at the back end of last season and are likely to be thereabouts too.

- 4 GASPER DE LEMOS A winner at 7f on yielding soft ground. Beaten 6l by Arabian Crown when second of 4 at 11-5 on his latest outing here over 1m 2f (soft) in October last year.
- 5 IMMORTAL KNIGHT A winner at 4-1 at Kempton over 1m on his latest outing in December last year, beating Fighter Command by 1l.
- 6 JAYAREBE A winner at 7f on good to firm ground. Beaten 6l behind Rosallion when seventh of 11 on his latest outing in the Group 1 Qatar Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at ParisLongchamp over 7f (good to soft) in October last year.
- 7 NARKEZ Successful twice at 1m on heavy ground. A winner at 11-4 at Saint-Cloud over 1m (heavy) on his latest outing last month, beating Supercooled by 7l.

RACE 3: BET365 EARL OF SEFTON STAKES (GROUP 3)

Embesto Royal Rhyme Ottoman Fleet

A winner of three of his five starts last season, including when sharing the spoils at this level in the Sovereign Stakes, EMBESTO looks an exciting proposition for the Roger Varian stable this year. Stepping up in trip should hold no fears for a son of Roaring Lion and he is narrowly preferred to Royal Rhyme, who takes a significant drop in grade having finished a respectable fifth in Champion Stakes. Ottoman Fleet won a weaker-looking renewal of this contest last year, but should be fit after some recent spins in Meydan. Last year's 2000 Guineas runner-up Hi Royal could be rejuvenated by a return to the Rowley Mile.

- 6 NOVUS She has won four times from 6f to 1m 2f on soft ground. A winner at 9-1 here over 1m 2f (soft) on her latest outing in October last year, beating Veil Of Shadows by 2l.
- 7 OTTOMAN FLEET He has won four times from 1m 1f to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to soft and on the all-weather. Beaten 9l behind Naval Power when eighth of 14 on his latest outing in the Group 2 Singspiel Stakes TURF at Meydan over 1m 1f (good) in February.
- 8 REGAL REALITY Winner of six races from 7f to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. Finished 3 1/2l behind Blue Trail when fourth of 7 at 5-2fav on his latest outing at Lingfield over 1m 2f in November last year.
- 9 ROYAL RHYME He has won four times from 7f to 1m 2f on good to soft and soft ground. Finished 5l behind King Of Steel when fifth of 8 at 16-1 on his latest outing in the Group 1 Qipco Champion Stakes at Ascot over 1m 2f (soft) in October last year.

RACE 4: LANWADES STUD NELL GWYN STAKES (FILLIES' GROUP 3)

Dance Sequence Matrika True Cyan

The last four winners of this race had previously tasted Newmarket success, which bodes well for supporters of DANCE SEQUENCE. Charlie Appleby's filly is unbeaten in two starts to date and on the back of game C&D triumph in the Oh So Sharp, with the promise of more improvement to come, she edges preference. Matrika's two-year-old season culminated in an impressive victory over 6f at the Curragh and she commands respect for the in-form Aidan O'Brien team. True Cyan made a pleasing start when running out a cosy winner of the same C&D maiden the stable's 2019 Nell Gwyn heroine Qabala took, and she completes the shortlist.
