Bayraq impressed when last seen over C&D in October and he is likely to be thereabouts along with Doncaster winner Maljoom, who is bred to improve for the step up in trip.

3 **MALJOOM** Dam unraced. A winner at 13-2 at Doncaster over 7f (good) on his latest outing last month, beating Encourageable by 1 1/4l.

4 **SAGA** Won on his latest outing when 2-5fav at Ascot over 7f (good) in September last year, beating Koy Koy by 1 1/4l.

SOMETHING ENTICING was as consistent as they come last season and the switch to Andrew Balding has the potential to eke out further improvement in the son of Fascinating Rock, who was last seen finishing second in Listed company at Doncaster. Diamond Bay has form figures of 112 over C&D, so must be a big player along with Hasty Sailor, who has an excellent record on the all-weather. November Handicap winner Farhan can also have a say along with Aaddeey.

1 **AADDEEY** He has won three times from 1m 2f to 1m 4f. Won on his latest outing when 2-1fav at Doncaster over 1m 4f (soft) in October last year, beating Dark Jedi by a neck.

- 2 KENZAI WARRIOR He has won three times from 7f to 1m including a win on polytrack. Beaten 1/2l by Fox Tal when second of 3 at 9-4 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f in January.
- 3 THRONE HALL Successful at 1m 1f and 1m 2f. Well beaten at 9-4fav behind Raymond Tusk when last of 7 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 1m 4f (good) last month.
- 4 BELLOCCIO Successful twice at 1m. Finished 14l behind Prince De Montfort when sixth of 7 on his latest outing at Saint-Cloud over 1m 2f in November last year.
- 5 SOMETHING ENTICING She has won three times from 1m to 1m 2f including a win on polytrack. Beaten 3/4l by Vesela when second of 18 at 18-1 on her latest outing at Doncaster over 1m 2f (soft) in November last year. Having her first run for a new stable today, previously with D R C Elsworth.
- 6 BOSS POWER He has won four times from 1m 3f to 1m 6f including 3 wins on the all-weather (1 PO). Finished 12l behind Volcanic Sky when last of 4 at 3-1 on his latest outing at Newmarket over 1m 4f (good) in August last year.
- 7 FARHAN Successful at 1m 2f and 1m 4f. Won on his latest outing when 9-2fav at Doncaster over 1m 4f (soft) in November last year, beating Calling The Wind by 1 3/4l.
