Mick Channon won this 12 months ago and his son, Jack, has every chance of following up this year with PHOENIX GLOW, who was second to a rejuvenated Brian The Snail at Bath recently and remains on the same mark, with Rose Dawes' 5lb claim of assistance. Concierge impressed at Bath last month with a comfortable victory and an added 4lb may not stop from him going well again, while Batchelor Boy has won here three times off higher marks and could bounce back to form.

- 1 HEY MR Successful twice at 5f on good to firm and soft ground. Beaten 1 3/4l behind Show Me Show Me at 9-2 when seventh of 9 on his latest outing at Beverley over 5f (good to soft) last month. Having his first run for a new stable today, previously with P T Midgley.
- 2 THE PRINCES POET He has won four times from 5f to 6f on ground varying from firm to good and on the all-weather. Third of 4 behind Pop Dancer beaten 2 1/2l at 15-8fav on his latest outing here over 5f (good) earlier this month.
- 3 EIGHT MILE He has won three times from 6f to 1m on good to firm and good to soft ground and on the all-weather. Finished 4l behind Premiere Beauty when fourth of 7 at 7-2 on his latest outing at Lingfield over 6f (good to firm) last month. Has won 3 times this season.
- 4 MUMAYAZ Successful twice at 7f on good ground and on the all-weather. Third of 8 behind Lilkian beaten 1 3/4l at 15-2 on his latest outing at Kempton over 6f in July.

Decisive Call looks interesting on his handicap debut and first start for Gary Moore, as he steps up in trip with sufficient stamina in his pedigree to suggest it will suit. Miss Harmony was only beaten a neck at Yarmouth off 11lb lower last month and she also has to be considered, but HABANERO STAR is narrowly preferred. Trainer Gay Kelleway loves a winner here and has booked Billy Loughane to ride, which stands out, while a return to this grade is a bonus after her second in a better race at Goodwood last month.

- 2 PLATINUM PRINCE He has won four times from 1m to 1m 2f on good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 10l behind Lethal Touch at 4-1 when eighth of 11 on his latest outing at Epsom over 1m 2f (good) last month.
- 3 MISS HARMONY She has won three times from 7f to 1m 2f on good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten a neck by Flower Of Thunder when second of 8 at 6-1 on her latest outing at Yarmouth over 1m 2f (good) last month.

- 7 LOWICK Placed once in six starts. Beaten 10l behind City Escape at 15-2 when last of 8 on her latest outing at Ffos Las over 1m 2f (soft) earlier this month.
- 8 FLORENCE STREET A winner at 1m on the all-weather. Beaten 13l behind King of The Dance at 33-1 when 9th of 10 on her latest outing at Lingfield over 1m earlier this month.

She is taken to follow up today, despite a 5lb rise. Sword Beach is entitled to bounce back following his recent all-weather display at Lingfield last month, while Robusto, a recent winner at Newcastle, and On The Right Track appeal most of the remainder.

- 2 SWORD BEACH He has won three times from 1m to 1m 3f on good to firm and soft ground, but last win was over two years ago; has also won a hurdle. Finished 6l behind Different Tone when fifth of 10 at 12-1 on his latest outing at Lingfield over 1m 4f last month.
- 3 ON THE RIGHT TRACK Winner of six races from 1m 3f to 1m 4f on firm and good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 10l behind Mount Olympus at 25-1 when 9th of 12 on his latest outing at Goodwood over 1m 3f (good to soft) earlier this month. Has won at Bath and Wolverhampton this season.
