LAWFUL COMMAND showed plenty of tenacity over this course and distance, leading early before battling back after being headed. Brian Meehan's charge only had a neck in hand of Wodeton that day and is 1lb worse off, but the way he ran suggests he might be tough to pass once getting his nose in front. Spinaround won at Newmarket last season and returned to action with a narrow defeat at Wolverhampton last time, while Rousay could build on a solid handicap bow at Salisbury.

Anything like the form that saw her take second in the Cheveley Park Stakes last year could suffice here. Nazanin won a Group 3 at Ayr last year but was behind Benefit when the pair finished well down the field in the Fred Darling at Newbury, while Ventura Diamond belied odds of 100/1 to finish seventh in the Champions Sprint at Ascot last year and could be effective in this class.
