A number of the runners in this juvenile contest can be given solid chances and a narrow preference is for POETIKEL PIECE, who travelled well for a long way in the Two-Year-Old Trophy at Redcar last time and may have even more to offer now dropping in trip. Manila Scouse produced another good effort when finishing second at Pontefract eight days ago and is feared, while the newcomer Penway catches the eye on pedigree and can also be a factor.
