RACE 1: BET 10 GET 40 AT BETMGM HANDICAP

Cephalus	Taravara	Eddie Temple

Having won three of his last five starts, CEPHALUS heads the shortlist despite picking up a 5lb penalty for his most recent success. The Gary Moore-trained gelding was treated for stomach ulcers before his upturn in form began over this course and distance in December, and he hasn't looked back. Taravara (second) was just a head behind the selection at Kempton last month and rates the chief danger with a 6lb pull at the weights. Eddie Temple is the pick of the rest.

1 CEPHALUS Winner of seven races from 7f to 1m on the allweather (3 PO). A winner at 3-1 at Southwell over 1m on his latest outing earlier this month, beating Soames Forsyte by 1 1/2l. Carries a 5lb penalty today for that success. Has also won at Kempton this season.

2 POETIC FORCE Has won 15 races from 7f to 1m 2f including 10 wins on the all-weather (5 PO). Beaten 4 1/2l behind Cosmos Raj at 14-1 when seventh of 11 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f earlier this month.

3 LENNY'S SPIRIT Winner of seven races from 7f to 1m 2f including a win on the all-weather. Finished 6l behind I Still Have Faith when sixth of 15 at 14-1 on his latest outing at Newmarket over 1m 1f (good) in September last year.

Ethandun sets the standard based on last year's turf form, while the unexposed No Half Measures is also respected.
