With the majority of the field having something to prove at present, the most solid proposition appears to be EIGHT MILE. George Scott's inmate has been shaping as if this step up to a mile could unlock some potential and he looks ready to capitalise. Twilight Kiss's stamina, on the other hand, appeared to be stretched by the 1m2f trip here earlier in the month and she is feared most now returned to this distance. Handicap debutant Doves Of Peace is worth noting in the market.

Sumac wasn't disgraced when second in a classified stakes contest at Southwell recently and he should remain competitive on this return to handicap company, while Sajwaan could prove dangerous if allowed to dictate on the front end.

- 3 SHOT Unplaced in all six starts. Beaten 10l behind Kensington Agent at 50-1 when last of 7 on her latest outing at Kempton over 7f last month. Having her first run for a new stable today, previously with Tom Ward.
- 4 KITBAG A winner at 6f on polytrack. Beaten 1 3/4l by Captain Dandy when second of 11 at 18-5 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 6f earlier this month.

Dark Design and Champagne Supanova also merit consideration.

- 2 DARK DESIGN Winner of six races from 6f to 1m including 2 wins on polytrack. Finished 2l behind Jumira Bridge when fourth of 11 at 4-1 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 6f earlier this month.
- 3 MY BOY JACK A winner at 6f on the all-weather. Beaten a head by Blackjack when second of 9 at 7-2 on his latest outing at Southwell over 6f earlier this month.
- 4 TOPLIGHT Winner of five races at 5f on the all-weather (1 PO). Won on his latest outing when 5-6fav at Wolverhampton over 5f earlier this month, beating Autumn Flight by 1l. Has won twice at Wolverhampton this season.
- 5 FRISTEL Placed in three of 14 starts. Finished 1 1/4l behind Forever Dreaming when fourth of 11 at 11-1 on his latest outing at Southwell over 6f last month.

SHARP POWER bumped into a couple of nice prospects when finishing a good third at Southwell earlier this month. The son of Churchill kept on well over 6f that occasion and he should open his account, with improvement likely at this longer trip. Andrew Balding's string often improve for their initial racecourse experience and that could be the case with Sceptic, who was far from disgraced on his debut at Newmarket last October. Sugar Hill makes plenty of appeal on paper and is worth monitoring in the betting ahead of his first start.

- 3 SCEPTIC Half-brother to New York Angel, won at 1m. Finished 8l behind Bodorgan when fourth of 13 at 7-2 on his racecourse debut at Newmarket over 7f (good to soft) in October last year.
- 4 SHARP POWER Placed once in two starts. Third of 7 behind Yorkshire beaten 1l at 3-1 on his latest outing at Southwell over 6f earlier this month.
