Race Preview: Mostar Dreams has a good draw and can go well having won over shorter at Carlisle recently, but an added 9lb from the handicapper looks punitive and she may have to settle for a place. Arabian Leopard has to be considered after winning comfortably from off the pace at Newmarket, but a chance is taken on MAGIC BASMA. Last seen running on over shorter in Listed class at Newmarket, she makes her handicap debut off a mark of 84 which may underestimate her ability.
