RACE 1: LIVESCORE BET APPRENTICE HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (3YO PLUS)

TELE RED - YAASER - GRACIOUS LEADER

Race Preview: TELE RED has been running well without troubling the judge recently, but Karl Burke's charge is now 1lb lower than when landing the corresponding event 12 months ago. He is fancied to regain the winning thread at the expense of Yaaser, who drops in class from a 2lb lower mark, having been below-par over 7f here last time out. Unexposed three-year-old Gracious Leader has scope for further progress and he merits respect on his first start for the George Boughey team.

3	POWER OF GOLD	A winner at 1m on good to firm ground. Finished 1 3/4l behind Dain Ma Nut In when fourth of 13 at 16-1 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good) last month.
4	CANDONOMORE	A winner at 1m on soft ground. Beaten 17l behind Treasure Time at 66-1 when 13th of 16 on his latest outing at York over 1m (good to firm) in August.
5	YAASER	Winner of seven races from 7f to 1m on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 9l behind Jenni at 7-1 when seventh of 11 on his latest outing here over 7f (good to firm) last month.
6	DETECTIVE	Winner of seven races from 7f to 1m 3f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. Finished 2l behind Desert Falcon when fourth of 12 at 50-1 on his latest outing here over 7f (good to firm) last month.
7	GRACIOUS LEADER	A winner at 1m on the all-weather. Third of 11 behind Highland Spring beaten 1l at 11-10fav on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m in August. Having his first run for a new stable today, previously with Roger Varian.
8	STARLINER	A winner at 7f on soft ground. Finished 2 1/4l behind Desert Falcon when sixth of 12 at 33-1 on his latest outing here over 7f (good to firm) last month.
9	STRAYA	Unplaced in all ten starts. Finished 4 1/2l behind Style Of Life when fifth of 8 at 16-1 on her latest outing at Thirsk over 1m (good to soft) last month.

RACE 2: VIRGIN BET MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 5) (2YO ONLY)

WEISSMULLER - BLUE PINATUBO - INVITORIO

Race Preview: Although WEISSMULLER has yet to open his account after four attempts, Archie Watson's gelding sets a lofty standard with an official rating of 92. His rivals need to improve on what they achieved on debut and this looks a gilt-edged opportunity. The main threat might come from Blue Pinatubo, who showed good early pace in a Glorious Goodwood maiden. Invitorio is the pick of the other two.

4	WEISSMULLER	Foaled 13 Feb. Placed once in four starts. Third of 5 behind Symbol Of Strength beaten 1 1/2l at evens fav on his latest outing here over 5f (good) in July.

RACE 3: VIRGIN BET EVERY SATURDAY MONEY BACK HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (3YO PLUS)

SPIRIT OF ACKLAM - SOOWAIH - POL ROGER

Race Preview: A chance can be taken on SPIRIT OF ACKLAM, who has been given a bit of time off since disappointing in the London Gold Cup at Newbury in May. The son of Cracksman will find this assignment much more to his liking and with the likelihood of further progress, he can get back on track. Soowaih was narrowly denied at Hamilton recently and he remains of interest from an unchanged mark. Others to note include Pol Roger and Reyaadah Star.

2	JOHNNY RINGO	A winner at 7f on the all-weather. Beaten 4l behind Borgi at 4-1 when 9th of 13 on his latest outing at Newcastle over 1m in July.
3	SPIRIT OF ACKLAM	Successful at 1m and 1m 2f on good to soft and soft ground. Well beaten at 9-1 behind King's Gambit when last of 13 on his latest outing at Newbury over 1m 2f (good) in May.
4	YOUNG FIRE	Has won 13 races from 7f to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to heavy and on the all-weather. Beaten 16l behind Liberty Coach at 4-1fav when seventh of 13 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 1m 2f (soft) last month. Has won at York and Haydock this season.
5	SOOWAIH	A winner at 1m on the all-weather. Beaten a neck by Tafsir when second of 8 at 8-1 on his latest outing at Hamilton over 1m 4f (good to soft) last month.
6	SAVROLA	Successful at 1m and 1m 1f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Finished 8l behind Dain Ma Nut In when fourth of 7 at 12-1 on his latest outing at Musselburgh over 1m (good) last month.
7	CAN'T STOP NOW	He has won three times from 1m 1f to 1m 2f on good and good to soft ground; has also won two hurdles. Well beaten at 20-1 behind Liberty Coach when 11th of 13 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 1m 2f (soft) last month.
8	REYAADAH STAR	A winner at 1m 3f on the all-weather. Beaten 1/2l by Yorkshire Lady when second of 7 at 10-1 on her latest outing over this course and distance (good) last month.
9	JEWEL MAKER	Has won nine races from 7f to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to soft - heavy and on the all-weather. Finished 2 1/2l behind Yaaser when sixth of 12 at 13-2 on his latest outing here over 1m (good) last month.

10	TILSITT	Winner of six races from 1m to 1m 2f on ground varying from good to firm to soft and on the all-weather, but last win was over two years ago. Beaten 1/2l by Epidavros when second of 9 at 7-2fav on his latest outing at Hamilton over 1m 1f (good to soft) last month.

JENNI - DANZAN - RED MIRAGE

Race Preview: JENNI gained her first career success over C&D on her latest outing and the daughter of Mehmas makes plenty of appeal in her bid to strike again off a 3lb higher mark. Danzan has to enter the reckoning based on his third in the Bronze Cup last time, while others for the shortlist include Red Mirage, who hit the frame at Chester in June, and Clasina.
