**RACE 1: SPORTING TIMES RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (3YO TO 4YO)**

**CHARLES DARNAY - JOHN GALT - CRANACHAN**

Race Preview: Although unable to justify favouritism when finishing third over 1m at Southwell, CHARLES DARNAY still makes plenty of appeal upped further in distance. The son of Planteur boasts plenty of stamina in his pedigree and this extra half-mile may prove fruitful. John Galt has come home in fourth on both outings to date and might serve the most resistance to the selection, ahead of Cranachan.

**RACE 2: VISIT SRI LANKA HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (3YO ONLY)**

**MAGNIFICENT MEL - LIFE AFTER LOVE - FAITHFUL DREAM**

Race Preview: Life After Love supplemented a breakthrough victory at Southwell with a close-up second at Lingfield and another bold bid looks likely. However, it could be worth taking a chance on MAGNIFICENT MEL, who caught the eye with her finishing effort when going down by a neck at Wolverhampton and she may be ready to open her account. Faithful Dream is the pick of the remainder.

**RACE 3: SPORTING TIMES/SRI LANKA AWAITS YOU HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS)**

**BIG BARD - SUB THIRTEEN - TWILIGHT MADNESS**

Race Preview: A return to this venue proved just the tonic for BIG BARD when holding on to score towards the end of January. A 2lb nudge up the ratings looks workable for the veteran and a 10th career victory may beckon. Stable debutant Sub Thirteen arrives on the back of a respectable fourth at Southwell and a change of scenery could bring about some improvement. He is feared most, ahead of Twilight Madness.

**LADY DORA MAE - STAY SALTY - DANCE FANTASY**

Race Preview: It was only a matter of time before LADY DORA MAE broke through judged on her improved Lingfield display second time up, and she did the business at Southwell quite readily. Going handicapping now off what looks a workable mark, she can continue on an upward curve for a top trainer/jockey combination. Stay Salty won't go down without a fight and looked a nice prospect himself when winning at Chelmsford, while Dance Fantasy is steadily improving and also commands attention.

Race Preview: Course scorer Bold Suitor is very much a player on the pick of last year's form, but a 151-day absence is a slight concern and preference is for ICONIC TIMES. Also a previous Kempton winner, the four-year-old posted an improved effort at Lingfield recently and is well worth another chance over this trip. Keep an eye on Mission Command too.

**RACE 6: SRI LANKA WONDER OF ASIA HANDICAP (GBBPLUS RACE) (CLASS 3) (4YO PLUS)**

**SPANISH VOICE - DRAMATIC STAR - WHITCOMBE ROCKSTAR**

Race Preview: It's hard to ignore the claims of SPANISH VOICE, who hasn't looked back since his third on debut at Kempton in December 2024, winning two on the bounce. The son of Lope De Vega takes a step up in trip on his handicap bow and he will prove a tough nut to crack. Dramatic Star only found one too good in a warmer contest at Southwell in November and has to be respected, despite being 2lb higher. Whitcombe Rockstar is another to note.

Race Preview: The one who appeals most is EULALIA, who made the frame over 7f at this venue in October and now makes her first appearance for the Jack Morland yard. The daughter of Expert Eye sports a first-time tongue-tie, which might eke out the improvement required for her to get off the mark. Pride Eye is a player based on her shock Southwell victory two starts ago, while Moyowasi is another to keep an eye on.
