**RACE 1: ELSTON SUPPORTS UK FINANCIAL ADVISERS RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4)  
(3YO TO 5YO) (FROM GOODWOOD RACE 1)**

**ADALO - SHEBARA - DOODLING**

Race Preview: Shebara disappointed when sent off favourite at Chelmsford. She's better than that and can't be easily ruled out, while Doodling returned to the fray with a solid second at Kempton and also enters calculations. However, William Haggas sent out a newcomer to win this contest last year and a chance is taken on ADALO. The son of Isfahan is a half-brother to five winners and may well prove good enough at the first time of asking.

**SKY MAJESTY - FLORA OF BERMUDA - ROSY AFFAIR**

Race Preview: William Haggas has won three of the last seven runnings of this race and is represented by SKY MAJESTY in 2026, already a Group 2 winner and last seen finishing 10th to Asfoora in the Prix de l'Abbaye in October. If she is ready to roll on her first start of the season, the four-year-old could get the better of Flora Of Bermuda, who is rated 2lb her superior but yet to win on her seasonal return, leaving Rosy Affair for third.

**RACE 3: FITZDARES CHELMER FILLIES' STAKES (LISTED) (CLASS 1) (3YO ONLY) (FROM GOODWOOD RACE 2)**

**FITZELLA - ZOOMING - ARGENTINE TANGO**

Race Preview: FITZELLA landed a Group 3 sprint at Ascot last summer and should benefit from dropping back to 6f after her comeback run in the Nell Gwyn. She has strong claims in this lesser company. Zooming posted a decent effort when fifth in the Fred Darling at Newbury and may well improve past Argentine Tango. The latter won a Listed contest on fast ground last season, while Hassaleh may well prove up to this level, given she won a Newmarket maiden in impressive fashion on her reappearance.

**RACE 4: BETFRED HANDICAP (HERITAGE HANDICAP) (CLASS 2) (4YO PLUS) (FROM NEWMARKET RACE 2)**

**DOUBLE RUSH - ADDISON GREY - JAKAJARO**

Race Preview: DOUBLE RUSH is hard to oppose despite this being a competitive handicap on paper. He returned to action over C&D in mid-April with an impressive success by close to five lengths, and a 5lb penalty here leaves him 8lb well in at the weights compared to future contests. Addison Grey is due to go up 2lb after finishing a head second at Newbury and looks his biggest rival, followed by Robert Cowell's Jakajaro.

**RACE 5: FITZDARES CONQUEROR FILLIES' STAKES (LISTED) (CLASS 1) (3YO PLUS) (FROM GOODWOOD RACE 3)**

**BLUE BOLT - SHES PERFECT - KON TIKI**

Race Preview: BLUE BOLT returns to Listed level for the first time since winning at Sandown last July. Andrew Balding's filly ended the season with an excellent second in the Group 1 Sun Chariot Stakes at Newmarket and an entry in the Lockinge later this month suggests big things are expected this season. Unlucky in the French 1000 Guineas, Shes Perfect competed at the highest level last term. She returns from a lengthy absence, as does the promising Listed winner Kon Tiki, while Arisaig could also shape well.

**BULLET POINT - ALCARATH - MISTER WINSTON**

Race Preview: Alcarath is lightly raced for a four-year-old with just the four starts and is expected to have more to offer, but he might have to give way to BULLET POINT. A winner of both his starts at Newmarket, he returns after going over to Australia when not disgraced in November and the five-year-old is more than capable of defying top-weight. Mister Winston made all to win here in April but he may be caught late on carrying a 5lb penalty.

**MIRSKY - FLIGHT PLAN - SEA FORCE**

Race Preview: An excellent renewal of this contest which was won by Flight Plan 12 months ago. Karl Burke's charge is 8lb lower today but needs to leave a few moderate efforts behind him and it might pay to side with MIRSKY. Third, three places in front of the reopposing Sea Force on his seasonal return at Musselburgh last month, he still looks feasibly treated and is likely to take a step forward. Four-year-old's Blue Rc and City Of Poets both merit consideration, and don't rule out Bellarchi, who goes in search of a hat-trick following a brace of Musselburgh wins.

**AIN'T NOBODY - ASFOORA - RUMSTAR**

Race Preview: Asfoora debuts for a new yard with solid claims. She landed a couple of Group 1 sprints last year, including the Nunthorpe at York, where AIN'T NOBODY finished runner-up at a massive price. However, the latter reopposes on more favourable terms and Ryan Moore's presence suggests a bold bid is anticipated. Rumstar won last year's renewal on his seasonal return and can't be left out of calculations, while Jm Jungle won a Group 2 at Goodwood last term and Beckford's Folly is another worth a second look.
