TRUE CHARM - MENHAAL - TUMISHI

Race Preview: TRUE CHARM displayed plenty of promise when filling second place on his debut at Windsor 11 days ago and the son of Ardad could be hard to beat with the benefit of that experience. Menhaal failed to live up to market expectations on his first outing but it is far too soon to be writing him off, while Tumishi and Primal are the pick of the newcomers.

Race Preview: Fast Track and Miss Tuite both showed enough on their respective debuts to suggest that they can go well, but there are some eye-catching newcomers in this field. None more so than SENORITA BONITA, who cost 900,000gns at the Craven Breeze-Up in April and she merits plenty of respect as a result. Terminology, whose dam was second in the Marygate as a juvenile, was a 360,000 euro breeze-up purchase and is another to consider.

Fantasy Force is second on the list after an encouraging debut at York three weeks ago, while Social Symbol is another well-bred newcomer to consider.

Golden Step, Joud and Wootton's Gal are respected in that order, but they all need big steps forward to trouble the selection.

However, a narrow vote of confidence goes to KISS ME MY LOVE, who built on a promising second at Thirsk with a gutsy win over 1m at Redcar. A 3lb rise isn't insurmountable and this in-form filly is an attractive proposition. Superfortress and Donna Nook are other notable options.
