**RACE 1: BRITISH EBF PETER WILLETT FUTURE STAYERS' MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 2) (2YO ONLY)**

**MIGHTY BOY - PANTILE WARRIOR - SEACRUISER**

Race Preview: Pantile Warrior has progressed with each start to date and has to be of interest following a narrow defeat at Newbury. That said, preference is for MIGHTY BOY, who displayed plenty of promise when second in a valuable event at Deauville on his debut and the son of Zarak is entitled to improve for that experience. Watching Stars was well held in fourth on his racecourse bow at Newmarket but should not be discounted. All of the newcomers make some appeal, but Seacruiser is marginally the pick of them.

3	PANTILE WARRIOR	Foaled 8 Feb. Placed twice in three starts. Beaten 3/4l by Hopewell Rock when second of 10 at 8-1 on his latest outing at Newbury over 1m (good) last month.
4	PISTRUCCI	Foaled 7 Feb. Dam won at 1m 4f. Unplaced in both starts. Finished 4 1/2l behind King Casper when fifth of 11 at 25-1 on his latest outing at Haydock over 7f (good to firm) last month.
5	REGAL ULIXES	Foaled 8 Mar. Half-brother to Regal Reality, won six times between 7f and 1m 2f including five Group 3 races.
6	SEACRUISER	Foaled 14 Mar. Half-brother to Velerin, won three times between 7f and 1m 3f.
7	SIR WILLIAM	Foaled 19 Feb. Dam won at 1m 4f. Finished 10l behind Righthere Rightnow when sixth of 12 at 10-3 on his racecourse debut at Newmarket over 7f (good) last month.
8	STORMY MONDAY	Foaled 18 Feb. Dam won twice at 1m and 1m 4f. Finished 8l behind Pride Of Arras when sixth of 8 at 11-1 on his racecourse debut at Sandown over 1m (good) last month.
9	WATCHING STARS	Foaled 7 Feb. Dam won three times between 7f and 1m 2f including a Group 3 race. Finished 8l behind Righthere Rightnow when fourth of 12 at 9-4fav on his racecourse debut at Newmarket over 7f (good) last month.
10	WHATCOMBE	Foaled 4 Mar. Dam won three times between 7f and 1m 1f including a Group 3 race.

**RACE 2: WILLIAM HILL MOST TOP PRICE RUNNERS HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (3YO PLUS)**

**ALLIGATOR ALLEY - NIGHT ON EARTH - KISS AND RUN**

Race Preview: Night On Earth has to be of interest following his success at Catterick last week, but a 5lb penalty for that victory has to be a slight concern. As a result, the vote goes to ALLIGATOR ALLEY, who only found one too good over C&D 10 days ago and returns off the same mark. Kiss And Run scored over track and trip recently and is another with strong form claims.

1	NIGHT ON EARTH	Has won 12 races at 5f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Won on his latest outing when 85-40fav at Catterick over 5f (good) last month, beating Albegone by 1 1/4l. Carries a 5lb penalty today for that success. Has won 3 times this season.
2	ALLIGATOR ALLEY	Has won eight races at 5f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 2 1/4l by Enchanting when second of 6 at 11-2 on his latest outing over this course and distance (soft) last month.
3	ALMATY STAR	Successful twice at 5f on the all-weather. Beaten 8l behind Brave Nation at 22-1 when seventh of 8 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 5f (good to firm) last month.
4	SKALLYWAG BAY	She has won three times from 5f to 6f on the all-weather. Finished 2 1/2l behind Never Dark when fourth of 7 at 10-1 on her latest outing at Nottingham over 5f (good) in July.
5	KISS AND RUN	She has won three times from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. A winner at 10-3 over this course and distance (good) on her latest outing last month, beating Cluedo by 1 1/4l. Has also won at Windsor this season.
6	ANGLE LAND	Winner of seven races at 5f on ground varying from good to firm to soft and on the all-weather. Finished 5l behind Enchanting when last of 6 at 9-1 on her latest outing over this course and distance (soft) last month.
7	ANCIENT TIMES	Winner of five races from 5f to 6f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather, but last win was over two years ago. Beaten 8l behind Dashing Dick at 12-1 when eighth of 9 on his latest outing at Newmarket over 6f (good to firm) in July.

**RACE 3: CLEANSING SERVICES GROUP NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (3YO PLUS)**

**RETRACEMENT - SAMRA STAR - FOREST GATE**

Race Preview: Cases can be made for most of these, but RETRACEMENT is just the pick of them. The son of Australia caught the eye when third in a competitive maiden on his debut at Yarmouth in April and confirmed that promise when winning decisively on his sole subsequent outing at Pontefract in July. Samra Star has a similar profile to the selection and should not be discounted. Others to note are Forest Gate, Shimmering Spin and Radwan.

2	RETRACEMENT	Won on his latest outing when 3-10fav at Pontefract over 1m (good to firm) in July, beating Wind River by 2 1/2l.
3	URBAN LION	Won on his latest outing when 8-15fav at Chelmsford City over 1m last month, beating Breathless Spirit by 1/2l.
4	CASTLE PEAK	Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 7l behind Summer Of Love at 66-1 when seventh of 12 on his latest outing at Kempton over 7f in June.
5	SAMRA STAR	A winner at 12-1 at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f on her latest outing last month, beating Islanova by 2l.
6	FOREST GATE	Placed in both starts. Beaten 2l by Vanish when second of 8 at 10-1 on his latest outing at Newbury over 1m 2f (good to soft) in July.

7	SHIMMERING SPIN	Placed in both starts. Beaten 1/2l by Under Siege when second of 9 at 11-2 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 1m last month.
8	SIR LOWRY'S PASS	Half-brother to First Light, won twice at 1m 2f and 1m 4f. Finished 8l behind Prague when sixth of 13 at 18-1 on his racecourse debut at Sandown over 1m 2f (good to soft) in June.
9	TEX	Half-brother to Zudu Spirit, won four times at 5f and 6f.
10	WIND RIVER	Placed once in two starts. Beaten 2 1/2l by Retracement when second of 12 at 7-2 on his latest outing at Pontefract over 1m (good to firm) in July.
11	HILLBRIDGE	Yet to place in three starts. Beaten 15l behind Queens Fort at 11-2 when seventh of 10 on her latest outing at Lingfield over 1m 4f in June.

**RACE 4: WILLIAM HILL KEEP YOUR RACEDAY POSITIVE FILLIES' NURSERY (CLASS 4) (2YO ONLY)**

**WHERE'S CLARE - LADY LUZON - POUTING**

Race Preview: WHERE'S CLARE made every yard when returning an impressive winner at Nottingham a fortnight ago. She looks one to keep on the right side of and can defy a 6lb rise if allowed her own way on the front end. The progressive Lady Luzon has won two of her last three outings over the minimum trip and is worth another try over this extra furlong, while Pouting is a potential improver fitted with a hood on her first start in a nursery.

3	JAKARTA	Foaled 6 May. A winner at 6f on good ground. Beaten 8l behind Miss Fascinator at 10-1 when last of 8 on her latest outing at Newmarket over 7f (good) last month.
4	LADY LUZON	Foaled 14 Mar. Successful twice at 5f on good to firm and good ground. Won on her latest outing when 3-1fav at Chepstow over 5f (good to firm) last month, beating John's Dragon by 1/2l. Has also won at Hamilton this season.
5	POUTING	Foaled 7 Mar. Placed twice in four starts. Finished 5l behind Ghost Run when fifth of 10 at 6-1 on her latest outing at Newbury over 6f (good) in July.
6	ENIGMATIC PRINCESS	Foaled 10 Jan. Placed once in four starts. Finished 12l behind River Seine when last of 4 at 15-2 on her latest outing at Pontefract over 5f (good to firm) in July.
7	LEYHAIMUR	Foaled 15 Mar. A winner at 6f on the all-weather. Finished 1 3/4l behind Art Design when fourth of 11 at 8-1 on her latest outing at Southwell over 6f last month.
