RACE 1: **CHRISTINE BIELBY MEMORIAL HANDICAP (GBBPLUS RACE) (CLASS 4) (4YO PLUS) (FROM FFOS LAS RACE 1)**

MAXIDENT - ROAD TO WEMBLEY - KINGDOM OF STARS

Race Preview: MAXIDENT produced a better effort when taking the silver medal home over track and trip last time and has since switched to the Kevin Philippart De Foy yard. The son of Nathaniel might only need to reproduce that level of form in order to go one better. Road To Wembley failed to land a blow over 1m4f at York last time, but sports first-time cheekpieces and could step up. Last-time-out Kempton score Kingdom Of Stars completes the shortlist.

ALEEN - URGENT CALL - REVERBERATE

Race Preview: ALEEN showed plenty of improvement for her Carlisle debut when finishing third on a softer surface at Doncaster over this trip last month. If the Study Of Man filly continues to progress, she may come home in front. Urgent Call appears a serious rival after showing plenty of promise when trying to make all before finishing third at Musselburgh on his debut, while Reverberate is bred to be better than what he has shown to date and is another to consider.

CONJECTURE - DRYBURGH - HIGH ESTEEM

Race Preview: Dryburgh showed ability when fourth on debut at Newmarket in June and it would be no surprise to see him improve for that experience. However, CONJECTURE was just touched off into second at Thirsk last month and sets the standard with an official rating of 77. Sir Mark Prescott's juvenile looks to have been found a suitable opportunity to shed her maiden tag. Any market support for newcomer High Esteem would be interesting.

STARSHOT - RAIN CAP - OBEE JO

Race Preview: Obee Jo has won here four times, three of which were over this trip, but he hasn't been at his best recently and may have to settle for a place. Rain Cap ran on well to score over 6f at Pontefract last month and is one to take seriously, but STARSHOT gets the vote. The five-year-old won as he pleased at Newcastle last month over this trip and if he transfers that level to the turf, he may double up.

DOLLYANA - DIAMONDSINTHESAND - DANDY G BOY

Race Preview: Diamondsinthesand recorded his second course success on his most recent outing and should mount a bold bid, despite his 4lb penalty. Last-time-out Wolverhampton victor Dandy G Boy needs considering in here, but a chance can be taken on DOLLYANA. She bounced back to form when making the frame at Newbury last month and was kindly dropped 1lb for that effort.

RACE 6: HUGH JAMES HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS) (FROM CATTERICK RACE 3)

BOLLIN NEIL - STAR OF JUPITER - SOPHAR SOGOOD

Race Preview: BOLLIN NEIL has won over C&D and clearly has no stamina questions to answer. He wasn't beaten far when fourth at Redcar in July and has every chance off 1lb lower. Star Of Jupiter is five years younger and looks an interesting alternative on his best form, which includes a Chepstow second last month, and he may get the better of Sophar Sogood for second place.

HIERARCHY - PAPABELLA - DARK ROSA

Race Preview: Turned out again quickly after a determined success at Southwell last week, HIERARCHY could kick on and he can follow up under a 5lb penalty. Back to form with a strong runner-up effort at Chepstow latest, Papabella is expected to be thereabouts, as well as Dark Rosa, who has dropped back to a mark 3lb lower than her last success.
