RACE 1: VIRGIN BET NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (3YO PLUS)

CREATIVE QUEEN - ROGUE MESSIAH - ZAIN PRIMUS

Race Preview: Rogue Messiah made a promising start when scoring at Windsor before disappointing at Thirsk after proving difficult to ride in the closing stages. A gelding operation might aid his cause but the vote goes to CREATIVE QUEEN. She was a warm order when finishing second on debut at Newcastle in September and is entitled to improve for that experience. Zain Primus appeals most of the remainder.

RACE 2: VIRGIN BET FILLIES' RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (3YO TO 5YO)**GUESSTIMATE - EASTERN VEIL - IRISH INCENTIVE**

Race Preview: Eastern Veil stepped forward from her debut fourth at Southwell to get off the mark at Wolverhampton despite showing signs of inexperience. Andrew Balding's filly is entitled to have more to offer along with Irish Incentive, who went close at Southwell last time, but GUESSTIMATE is preferred. The daughter of Sea The Moon showed promise when runner-up on her second start over C&D and this appears to be an ideal starting point this season before potentially stepping up in trip.

RACE 3: VIRGIN BET DAILY PRICE BOOSTS MAGNOLIA STAKES (LISTED) (CLASS 1) (4YO PLUS)**GETHIN - DEVIL'S ADVOCATE - PLAG DE HAVRE**

Race Preview: Devil's Advocate struggled following his fourth in the Dante before bouncing right back to form in handicap company at Doncaster. He wasn't at all disgraced when being Ombudsman's pacemaker in the Champion Stakes but an official rating of 112 may just flatter him slightly. With that in mind, GETHIN looks the one to side with. Owen Burrows' colt was considered for a Derby trial after winning under a penalty at Newbury until meeting with a setback, which ruled him out until the autumn where he ran with credit twice in Listed company. Plage De Havre was impressive in the Old Newton Cup when last seen and is an interesting contender upped in class.

RACE 4: VIRGIN BET HANDICAP (GBBPLUS RACE) (CLASS 3) (4YO PLUS)

MARNIER - BAHADUR - TOPTEAM

Race Preview: MARNIER represents a top yard and has a good chance of making a successful handicap debut. The ready winner of a three-runner maiden at Lingfield when last seen, the John & Thady Gosden-trained gelding has stacks of potential and this will give his connections strong clues about where to go from here. Bahadur rounded off 2025 with a hat-trick on the all-weather, including a C&D victory in a novice event that has worked out well. He is feared more than Topteam, whose Polytrack form needs to be improved upon.

RACE 5: VIRGIN BET A GOOD BET FILLIES' HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (4YO PLUS)

MUSICAL ANGEL - LADY ROXBY - LADY MARIKO

Race Preview: MUSICAL ANGEL was consistent during her time with Andrew Balding and having changed hands for 50,000gns at the autumn sales, she has the potential to make a flying start for new connections. Cutting back to 6f shouldn't pose any issues and, having only gone up 3lb for winning at Epsom when last seen, this could be a good starting point. The reliable Lady Roxby and Lady Mariko are also capable of going close, while Mercury Day shouldn't be underestimated.

RACE 6: VIRGIN BET A GOOD BET HANDICAP (DIV 1) (CLASS 4) (4YO PLUS)

FINAL NIGHT - TED LE SAUX - HELM ROCK

Race Preview: Ted Le Saux can be forgiven his latest run as it was reported that he had an irregular heartbeat after the race. His previous two starts were highly encouraging and the betting can guide regarding any expectations of a revival. As a previous C&D winner running off a competitive rating, Helm Rock is another viable option. However, slender preference is for course-specialist FINAL NIGHT, whose four previous wins have all come over C&D.

RACE 7: VIRGIN BET A GOOD BET HANDICAP (DIV 2) (CLASS 4) (4YO PLUS)

BERRY CLEVER - CITY OF GOD - BROADWAY ACT

Race Preview: City Of God took advantage of the favourable terms to land a seller at Chelmsford in February. He will likely confirm superiority over Zoffandia (fifth) back in handicap company, but BERRY CLEVER could prove the one to side with. The latter ended last season with convincing success over C&D and Oisin Murphy's presence suggests he'll be primed for action on his return. Formerly with Charlie Appleby, Broadway Act is worth a second look debuting for new connections.

5	TENNESSEE GOLD	He has won three times from 6f to 7f including 2 wins on polytrack. Beaten 8l behind Dark Ace at 18-1 when 9th of 11 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 6f last month.
6	CANDONOMORE	He has won four times from 7f to 1m including a win on the all-weather. Finished 3 1/2l behind Champion Again Ole when fifth of 8 at 7-2 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 7f last month.
7	TASDEED	A winner at 7f on the all-weather. Beaten 9l behind Borgi at 11-1 when last of 7 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f last month.

RACE 8: VIRGIN BET HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (4YO PLUS)

MIO AMICO - FLEURMAN - BASHFUL BOY

Race Preview: Less exposed than most of these rivals, MIO AMICO is on an upward curve. Michael Keady's four-year-old supplemented his win at Lingfield in January with an impressive success over 1m6f at Chelmsford last time and there could be even more to come over this longer trip. Fleurman ended a barren spell when scoring over C&D and can feature once again, while the veteran Bashful Boy is still capable of making his presence felt.

6	MERRIJIG	Winner of five races from 1m 6f to 2m 1f including 2 wins on the all-weather (1 PO). A winner at 4-1 at Newcastle over 2m on his latest outing in November last year, beating Educate by a head.
7	PORT OF ENTRY	Unplaced in all five starts. Beaten 6l behind Manko at 20-1 when seventh of 14 on his latest outing at Lyon-Parilly over 1m 4f (good) in June '23. Having his first run for a new stable today, previously with A Fabre in France.
