RACE 1: DOWNLOAD THE AT THE RACES APP SELLING HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (3YO PLUS) (FROM LINGFIELD RACE 1)

CEZARRO - DOUGLAS DC - SAPPHIRE DREAM

Race Preview: CEZARRO ended his time under the tutelage of Ross Burdon with a respectable third over 1m2f on the turf track here. The four-year-old is a potential improver over the extra quarter-mile and this contest shouldn't take much winning. Brighton fifth Douglas Dc continues to creep down the ratings and he's worth a second look, along with Sapphire Dream, who is reverting to handicap company.

Race Preview: Redline made a winning debut at Carlisle and the manner of that victory suggested an extra furlong wouldn't be an inconvenience to Charlie Johnston's filly. Don't Stop Movin is likely to be in the mix following his runner-up effort at Redcar in May, but the vote goes to TEN CLARETS. Karl Burke's colt shaped with promise when fourth at York and the form has since been boosted by the second going one better.

Race Preview: Cavalier should have learned plenty from his opening sixth at Newbury and an improved performance would come as no surprise. Richard Hannon's colt isn't taken lightly, but Windsor runner-up PERFECT NATION rates as the one to beat. Although the son of Sioux Nation was no match for the winner that day, this step up in distance promises to suit. Ralph Beckett has done well with his juveniles this season, so newcomer Drum Bay is worth a second look in the betting.

Race Preview: A wind operation and a first-time tongue-tie may see an upturn in fortune for Hill O Rue after disappointing on both starts in 2026. Naturalia has been knocking hard on the door with a trio of runner-up efforts and she is expected to be competitive once again. However, the vote goes to RUMBUSTIOUS. The son of Dubawi appears likely to benefit from a drop back in trip based on his last couple of starts and he may be able to take advantage of the weight-for-age allowance.

Race Preview: ROMANZA was far from disgraced when finishing seventh in the Chesham and he's expected to be in the thick of the action in these calmer waters. A similar performance from the son of Frankel may prove sufficient and he gets the vote over Cloud Summit. George Boughey's colt posted a promising fourth on his debut at Newbury and this extra yardage should see him in a better light. Victory Gold is another to note up in distance.

The extra half-mile is unlikely to be an inconvenience and he can strike under a 6lb penalty. Break Point returned to the level with a victory on the same day at Kempton and looks to be the main threat, while Artavian heads the remainder.

Race Preview: Hunterian supplemented two creditable efforts in defeat with a triumph over C&D. Charlie Johnston's colt must enter calculations off 3lb higher, but EY UP HE'S A STAR is slightly more compelling. The four-year-old travelled with more verve in first-time cheekpieces when finishing third in an 18-runner affair at Doncaster and, off an unchanged mark, he may prove to be better treated. Flying Moonlight is the pick of the remainder.
