**RACE 1: LK BENNETT LADY AMATEUR JOCKEYS HANDICAP (FEMALE AMATEUR JOCKEYS) (STR) (CLASS 4) (4YO PLUS)**

**CRYSTAL CASQUE - LAW SUPREME - DAKOTA POWER**

Race Preview: Power Of Gold was narrowly denied over 7f at Doncaster last time out and must be respected back at the mile, while last-start Ffos Las scorer Dakota Power is another likely to prove popular. However, there have been more encouraging signs from last year's winner CRYSTAL CASQUE of late. Rod Millman's mare is now 5lb lower than for that triumph and a repeat could be on the cards. Law Supreme is another to consider.

2	DOUBLE TIME	He has won four times from 1m to 1m 1f on good to soft ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 7l behind Brasil Power at 28-1 when eighth of 14 on his latest outing at Kempton over 7f last month.
3	MASTER OF COMBAT	He has won four times from 1m to 1m 1f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 5l behind Devoirs Choice at 80-1 when eighth of 14 on his latest outing at Newbury over 1m (good to firm) last month.
4	CRYSTAL CASQUE	Has won 13 races from 7f to 1m on ground varying from good to firm to soft and on the all-weather. Third of 8 behind Ziggy's Phoenix beaten 1 1/2l at 14-1 on her latest outing at Goodwood over 1m (good to soft) last month.
5	SHALADAR	He has won three times at 1m on good and good to soft ground, but last win was over two years ago. Finished 3 1/2l behind Lerwick when fourth of 10 at 10-1 on his latest outing at Beverley over 1m (good to firm) last month.
6	POWER OF GOLD	A winner at 1m on good to firm ground. Beaten a neck by Musical Mystery when second of 11 at 14-1 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 7f (good to firm) last month.
7	LAW SUPREME	Successful twice at 1m on soft ground. Beaten 3/4l by Arkhalia Flynn when second of 8 at 7-1 on his latest outing at Windsor over 1m (soft) last month.
8	ALAZWAR	He has won four times from 7f to 1m 1f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather; has also won a NH flat race. Finished 17l behind Finn Russell when sixth of 7 at 6-1 on his latest outing at Carlisle over 1m 1f (good) last month.
9	DESERT DOCTOR	Has won ten races from 5f to 1m on good and good to soft ground and on the all-weather. Finished 8l behind Stately Home when sixth of 7 at 9-1 on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m in January.
10	DAKOTA POWER	He has won three times from 6f to 7f on soft ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 7-4 at Ffos Las over 7f (soft) on his latest outing last month, beating Monsieur Patat by 4 1/2l. Has also won at Salisbury this season.
11	ONE STEP BEYOND	Has won eight races from 7f to 1m 2f on good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 6l behind Dreamrocker at 14-1 when 9th of 11 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good to soft) in July.
12	LITTLE EMPIRE	Successful at 7f and 1m on good ground and on the all-weather. Unseated rider when 17-2 at Navan over 1m (good) won by Shigar last month on his latest outing. Has won at Ayr and Wolverhampton this season.

13	TERRIES ROYALE	Placed twice in six starts. Finished 4l behind Zozimus when fourth of 13 at 16-1 on his latest outing at Pontefract over 1m (good to firm) last month.
14	MUMAYAZ	He has won four times from 6f to 1m on good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 2 1/4l by Oj Lifestyle when second of 6 at 7-2 on his latest outing at Brighton over 1m (good to firm) last month.

**RACE 2: CHARBONNEL ET WALKER BRITISH EBF MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 3) (2YO ONLY)**

**ISAMBARD BRUNEL - AL SAMED - CALLA LAGOON**

Race Preview: This looks a warm contest on paper, with the likes of Al Samed, Tornado Alert and Frankini all making some appeal ahead of their debuts. Experience might prove to be crucial, though, and it is the Aidan O'Brien-trained ISAMBARD BRUNEL who shades preference. The son of Justify didn't quite get home over the mile at Newbury three weeks ago, but he ought to be wiser this time around and could step forward now eased in trip. Others to note include Calla Lagoon, Fifth Column and Seaplane.

**BALLET SLIPPERS - GLISTENING - KYLIE OF LOCHALSH**

Race Preview: BALLET SLIPPERS was third behind a potentially smart type on her Curragh debut before finding another exciting prospect too strong there next time. The daughter of Dubawi, who is the first foal out of the brilliant Magical, should be even better now sent over a mile and looks set to strike at the third time of asking. Glistening has produced a similar level of form across her two starts and is unlikely to be far away, while the penalised Kylie Of Lochalsh is taken to chase them home.

**DIEGO VENTURA - BEAUTY BY MY SIDE - NEWLYN SCHOOL**

Race Preview: Now in the colours of Wathnan Racing and switched to trainer Hamad Al Jehani after a taking debut victory at Naas in July, DIEGO VENTURA is likely to have plenty more improvement to come and he can defy his penalty. He gets the vote ahead of promising Windsor fourth Newlyn School and Beauty By My Side, who was an eyecatcher when staying on late at Yarmouth first time out.
