RACE 1: EVERY RACE LIVE ON RACING TV APPRENTICE HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (3YO PLUS) (FROM LEICESTER RACE 1)

BULLINGTON BRY - MIAKODA - PORTORO

Race Preview: BULLINGTON BRY struggled in a tougher contest at Newmarket last time, but remains of interest back at this level. Denied by only a short-head when runner-up under this apprentice at Ffos Las in August, the third home has since franked that form and Jane Chapple-Hyam's charge could be bang there at the finish once again. Miakoda returns to the turf with a shout, while Portoro could make his presence felt after going close over 6f here.

Snaafy posted an improved effort at Haydock last time and is another likely to appreciate this longer trip, while A Taste of Glory is also worth noting on the back of his fourth at Goodwood.
