**RACE 1: LADIES DAY 9TH MAY 'CONFINED' NOVICE STAKES (GBB/GBBPLUS RACE) (DIV 1) (CLASS 3) (3YO PLUS)
(FROM NOTTINGHAM RACE 1)**

INFRAAD - DIRECTOR'S CUT - YOU GOT TO MY SOUL

Race Preview: Director's Cut took a step forward to score at Newcastle in November and will appreciate this rise in trip. However, he might find it tough to give his penalty away to INFRAAD, who finished five lengths clear of the third when second over a mile at Doncaster on his sole juvenile start and is likely to have plenty more in the locker. You Got To My Soul is the pick of the remainder.

TORNADO TOWER - AUSTRALIA DAY - OLYMPIC CHARTER

Race Preview: Australia Day changed hands for 180,000gns as a yearling and is a half-brother to Zenga, who placed at Listed level on her final start, so he is one to watch in the market. Godolphin newcomer Olympic Charter is related to plenty of winners and could go well, but TORNADO TOWER makes the most appeal on paper. The Goddens' colt is a brother to Irish Derby and St Leger hero Hurricane Lane and if he possesses even half of his ability, he will prove a tough nut to crack.

Race Preview: It paid to follow Karl Burke in the juvenile division last season and, for that reason, FINAL APPEAL gets the vote. By Inns Of Court and out of a half-sister to Australian Group 1 winner Sir John Hawkwood, it would be no surprise to see him make a successful debut. Rotelle cost 40,000gns as a yearling and has plenty of speed in his pedigree so he is one to watch out for. Any market support behind Blackberry Bold would be interesting.

Race Preview: Spendmore Lane's winning run came to an end at Chelmsford last time but she should not be discounted, despite a further 4lb rise. That said, preference is for IORELLA PRINCESS, who has been running well in defeat on the all-weather of late and was successful when last seen on turf at Sandown in September. Albegone and Glory Fighter complete the shortlist.

Race Preview: DRYBURGH relished the step up to this trip when filling third place at Doncaster 10 days ago and Oli Rix's gelding merits the utmost respect off the same mark. Extraterrestrial was third on his handicap debut at Wolverhampton last time and may improve with a first-time visor now applied. Cases can be made for all of the remainder, but Al's River is the pick of them.

He did not appear to quite get home over 1m2f on that occasion and the six-year-old should relish this drop in trip. Rosemary's Rose has been in good form on the all-weather in recent months and is another to consider.

Race Preview: Jamie Osborne won a division of this 12 months ago and would not be without a chance courtesy of the consistent Aneirin's Sword, but there a number of less exposed rivals who could find further progress. LIGHT THE NIGHT UP showed plenty in novice events before finishing third on her handicap bow and it might be that returning to the mile while switching to turf holds the key for Karl Burke's filly. Kokushoku and Venetian Romance are notable handicaps debutants, and Bird Of War is no forlorn hope either.

Race Preview: CAVOLO NERO made a pleasing return to action at Kempton last month, keeping on well in the closing stages to grab second place. He steps into unknown territory regarding distance but his dam stayed this trip, and trainer James Ferguson has been among the winners of late. C&D winner Just An Hour is seldom far away and although that might be the case again, Moon Beginnings could be a bigger threat.

Race Preview: GO RIMBAUD chased home the well-touted Talk Of New York here and then finished second to another smart prospect of Godolphin's in Fort Rock. The Palace Pier colt is clearly going the right way and sets a good standard. There are some interesting newcomers in opposition, not least Turret, who cost Juddmonte 580,000 euros and is from the top Coolmore family of Hydrangea and Hermosa. Besieged, who is out of Falmouth winner Snow Lantern, and Electric Dreams weren't much cheaper, while Romanticizing was bought for 180,000gns and is related to some smart performers.

Race Preview: Domenico Contarini was an expensive breeze-up purchase and showed ability when runner-up at Newcastle. He will build on that, and better is also expected from Zatsgood now that he has a comeback second at the Gosforth Park venue under his belt. Flying Squad has been gelded since a satisfactory Southwell introduction, but HERALDRY is fancied to take the biggest step forward. The Goddens' son of Kingman was in need of the experience at Newcastle in November, but still offered plenty of encouragement and will probably stay further than this.
