RACE 1: CAA STELLAR GREAT CHESHIRE HANDICAP (GBBPLUS RACE) (CLASS 2) (4YO PLUS) (FROM CHESTER RACE 1)

RESPOND - GREAT DAVID - EL BURHAN

Race Preview: Only one of the last eight winners of this has come out of a stall higher than the six box, which suggests that RESPOND has every chance. Successful at Chelmsford in March and third at Kempton over further since, Andrew Balding's gelding could be tough to peg back. Great David should appreciate the return to handicap company after being found wanting in Listed and Group 3 races last year, although a mark of 102 seems high enough. El Burhan might hit a place from a fractionally higher draw.

Race Preview: William Haggas has won three of the last seven runnings of this race and has every chance of another here with ALBAYDAA, who won over this trip at Wolverhampton last year. She made her handicap debut off this mark at Newmarket over 6f where she ran on into third and should be far better suited by the extra furlong. Colori Forever could go well if he gets a fast pace to aim at, followed by the interesting Queen Tamara.

Race Preview: Glory Of The Seas could prove popular in the Godolphin blue for Roger Varian, but he needs to take a step forward after a seven-and-a-half-length fourth at Newbury. GALIYAN showed his inexperience on debut at Newmarket when ducking at the start and running green before finishing fourth, but it will be a huge surprise if he doesn't learn plenty from that experience. Joulany is getting better with racing and cannot be discounted, while Distorted Truth needs forgiving her last run to figure.

Third after weakening close home on her debut at Newmarket, she could improve significantly here. Half A Hoof and Wondervision are other newcomers to note in a wide-open contest.

LAMBOURN - BAY CITY ROLLER - KING'S GAMBIT

Race Preview: Last year's Derby winner LAMBOURN looks poised to make a winning return to action back at the site of his Chester Vase victory. After a couple of below-par runs at the end of the season, the application of cheekpieces here can sharpen the colt up. George Scott's Bay City Roller rounded out his season with Group 1 success in Germany and may be the most likely challenger to the Derby winner. King's Gambit was no match for the winner when second in the Sefton Stakes last month but may be better for the run. Curragh Group 3 winner Starford arrives here having made a solid start to his season but will have to overcome the widest draw from stall nine, while Royal Rhyme may appreciate a softer surface than this.

GALILEO DAME - BLINDEDBYTHELIGHTS - TEAM PLAYER

Race Preview: Joseph O'Brien boasts a strong hand here with GALILEO DAME the most appealing of the lot. The mare comes here in good form off the back of a second-placed effort at Navan and boasts proven stamina from her success over hurdles. This race can often go to a dual-purpose performer and the booking of Ryan Moore certainly catches the eye. O'Brien also saddles the lightly-raced A Piece Of Heaven and Irish Cesarewitch/Cheltenham Festival winner Puturhandstogether, who won't mind the big field but has been handed the widest draw of all in stall 17. Blindedbythelights is a consistent type but has been unable to get his head in front since June 2023 and finds himself 22lb higher than that now. The hat-trick seeking Team Player has won both his starts since joining Ewan Whillans and the four-year-old could have more improvement left in him.

ELEMENTS OF FIRE - HUCKLESBROOK - TOYOTOMI

Race Preview: Progressive on the all-weather, ELEMENTS OF FIRE landed hat-trick of 7f victories with last month's Wolverhampton success. This stiff 6f should suit the front-running son of Too Darn Hot and Archie Watson's rapid improver may not have finished winning yet. Hucklesbrook made an encouraging reappearance at Newbury. He won a higher grade sprint at York last summer and has solid claims on that form, while Toyotomi looks on a tempting mark and shouldn't be underestimated.

Race Preview: We all know the value of a low draw at Chester, especially in the sprints, and if HOODIE HOO starts well from the four stall, he has every chance. Second on his return at Lingfield after over five months off, nominal improvement would give him every chance off the same mark. Clonmacash heads over from Ireland after winning at Dundalk and has to be considered off 3lb higher, while Paws For Thought has won here six times and may hit a place from the less-advantageous nine stall.
