**RACE 1: GET RACEDAY READY HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (4YO PLUS) (FROM BRIGHTON RACE 5)**

**TIME PATROL - BINT HAVANA GOLD - ZU RUN**

Race Preview: TIME PATROL hasn't looked back since returning to turf in April with three victories here, including over C&D at the end of last month, and the five-year-old gets the vote to continue his good form. Zu Run justified favouritism over C&D last time but has to contend with a 6lb rise. With that in mind, Bint Havana Gold, who has been a model of consistency in recent months, may prove to be the bigger threat.

**KRANJCAR - BEAR TO DREAM - RIVER WHARFE**

Race Preview: Bear To Dream gained a fourth success here in a classified event last week and escapes a penalty. River Wharfe got the better of stable companion Poetic Force (third) and Comedian Leader (fourth) when the trio met at this track over a mile last month. KRANJCAR gets the nod, though. George Boughey's gelding can be forgiven his latest effort at Chelmsford, having stumbled leaving the stalls, and is much better judged on his C&D success the time before.

**HK FOURTEEN - SERGEANT MAYER - DAPPERLING**

Race Preview: HK FOURTEEN remains unexposed on the turf and showed up well over C&D recently when keeping on well for third. Dropping 1lb will make life easier and he is narrowly preferred to Sergeant Mayer, who was denied the hat-trick when behind an in-form subsequent winner at Carlisle last time out. Turned out again quickly after a taking success over further at Goodwood on Friday, Dapperling must be of interest.

**DICTAL - BELLA LYRA - HASSALEH**

Race Preview: No stranger to first-time-out winners, trainer Andrew Balding looks to have a nice filly in DICTAL, who is by Frankel out of a Listed-winning mare over this distance. Fellow newcomer Hassaleh's pedigree suggests she will want further in time, while Bella Lyra sets the standard having finished creditably behind a smart sort of Hugo Palmer's on debut at Haydock. Country Artiste and Gnocchi are other debutants to note.

NAHRAAN - JUPITER AMMON - EARTHWATCH

Race Preview: NAHRAAN looked a smart colt when hampered at the start and short of room at a crucial point en route to scoring on debut at Wolverhampton. Stepping up in trip is likely to bring about plenty of improvement and he should have too much for Jupiter Ammon, who was last seen rallying late in the piece over 1m at Chelmsford. Earthwatch and Relocal haven't shown much so far, but are dangerous to ignore given their connections.

REGAL ENVOY - ROSARIO - CHANGE SINGS

Race Preview: Oisin Murphy has forged a good partnership with REGAL ENVOY. The combination struck at Newmarket in April before scoring here three weeks ago and the son of Ardad can continue to defy the handicapper. Rosario had excuses at Newbury last time and is better judged on his victory in this grade at Goodwood prior to that, while Change Sings was headed in the dying strides over 6f here latest and could also have a say.

Race Preview: Christmas Gift represents last year's winning trainer and will likely improve for this extra furlong, while Beauty Beyond could also find enough improvement to make her presence felt. However, that pair do not set a particularly high standard and a chance is taken on ALMEKAREM. The son of Kingman is a half-brother to several useful types, including the Listed winner Rakan, and may well prove good enough at the first time of asking.
