RACE 1: MARINER SYSTEMS FILLIES' HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (3YO PLUS) (FROM ASCOT RACE 6)

MORROPHORE - ROCK CAMELOT - AIMING HIGH

Race Preview: A novice winner last term, MORROPHORE finished a promising third over a mile at Southwell on her handicap debut. She looks on a workable mark on that evidence and this extra test of stamina will suit the daughter of Kingman. Rock Camelot is also unexposed and is likely to improve after finding one too good at Wetherby on her handicap bow. Aiming High has been in fine form on the all-weather and drops down in trip with a shout off her current mark.

DREAM OF MISCHIEF - ARNAZ - SMART VISION

Race Preview: DREAM OF MISCHIEF was narrowly denied when coming out second best in a fight to the line at Kempton. A winner over 7f and a mile, he will appreciate the stiff 6f at this track and Jack Dace's 7lb allowance further helps his cause. Arnaz enters calculations after going close at Haydock on his reappearance, while Doncaster third Smart Vision could also land a blow. Last year's winner Northcliff arrives in fine form, although he is 10lb higher on this occasion.

Race Preview: MOGHITHA displayed plenty of promise when filling third place on her debut at Thirsk a week ago and the daughter of Ghaiyyath could be hard to stop with the benefit of that experience. Lexington Express is bred to be fast and it would be no surprise to see her go well on her racecourse bow, while similar comments apply to Shaman Champion.

BEAULD AS BRASS - GUENDOLEN - GLIMMER OF LIGHT

Race Preview: BEAULD AS BRASS arrives on the back of a hat-trick of victories in recent weeks and the in-form five-year-old is very hard to oppose once again, despite a 5lb penalty for the most recent of those wins at Bath on Monday. Guendolen also scored on her latest outing and is the most obvious threat to the selection, while Glimmer Of Light is next best.

OUTRUN THE STORM - NAVAL ACADEMY - LEAP DAY

Race Preview: The handicapper has given OUTRUN THE STORM a chance by dropping him 2lb after a fourth-placed finish at Catterick. That was actually an improvement on his recent form and, as a previous C&D scorer running off 6lb below his last winning mark, this could be a good time to catch Richard Fahey's gelding. Catterick runner-up Leap Days might struggle to reel in the selection on the revised terms, so the well-handicapped Naval Academy could be a bigger danger.

DARK TORNADO - LOOKS FANTASTIC - INDIAN SPIRIT

Race Preview: DARK TORNADO boasts an official rating of 90 and has a golden opportunity to get off the mark after an encouraging second over C&D on his first start for Denis Quinn. That was also his first appearance since being gelded and he seems more like the finished article. Looks Fantastic and Indian Spirit are the most obvious threats, with the former feared most after filling the runner-up spot on his return at Southwell.
