RACE 1: KBIS BRITISH EQUESTRIAN INSURANCE EBF NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (2YO ONLY) (FROM NEWBURY RACE 1)

SOLE AMBITION - AL QAYED - AMIR LEHBAB

Race Preview: An interesting novice to begin proceedings with some exciting pedigrees on offer. Al Qayed is a fascinating runner for William Haggas given he is from the first crop of Baaeed and comes from an excellent family on the dam's side. However, it may well be that he will come into his own over further later in the season, so the vote goes to SOLE AMBITION. His sale price as a foal increased by 60,000gns at Tattersalls Book 1 last October and he represents a stable enjoying a fine campaign so far. Others worth considering include Amir Lehabab, Cloud Summit and Jimtrott.

SYDNEY ROCK - LAHAN KINGMAN - THE STONE POWER

Race Preview: SYDNEY ROCK showed plenty of promise on all three juvenile starts over 7f, finishing second on each occasion, and the extra furlong on her handicap debut is likely to bring about improvement from Oliver Cole's filly. Lahan Kingman looked to be awkward on her latest start at Lingfield and the application of blinkers may well be the solution. The Stone Power and Box Clever head the remainder.

RACE 3: ARDONAGH GROUP HANDICAP (STR) (CLASS 3) (4YO PLUS) (FROM NEWBURY RACE 3)**FORTY YEARS ON - NOSTRUM - ATA RANGI**

Race Preview: Nostrum appreciated a drop in grade when filling the runner-up spot at Sandown a fortnight ago and that confidence-boosting effort entitles him to be on the shortlist. Ata Rangı went up 4lb for winning at Haydock on his return to action and commands plenty of respect, but the unexposed FORTY YEARS ON appeals most. George Scott's filly won three of her five starts last season and the form of her final start was boosted by the winner landing a valuable handicap at the Dante meeting.

RIGHTHERE RIGHTNOW - JUSTCALLMEPETE - GOLDEN LONG

Race Preview: Unlike when winning a 0-100 at Windsor last month, Justcallmepete finds himself near the head of the handicap. He doesn't have the aid of Myla Coppins' claim either but even so, he must still enter calculations. Golden Long hasn't been with Lemos De Souza for long and might still be capable of better having also been victorious at Windsor last time, but a chance can be taken on RIGHHERE RIGHTNOW. Richard Spencer's gelding posted a few decent efforts out in Dubai over the winter but returns to home soil on a competitive mark. He was fifth in the Ayr Silver Cup from 5lb higher last year so is entitled to go well should the penny drop.

TARRANT - SHADY DAME - MISS SCOTT

Race Preview: Both of TARRANT's starts so far have worked out well and Richard Hannon's filly might be well placed to break her duck at the third time of asking. There are a few that could challenge though, namely Shady Dame, who drops in class having struggled to make an impact in the Oh So Sharp Stakes at Newmarket. Stable companion Miss Scott already has a win to her name but is likely to need a bit more under a penalty on her return, whilst market support for the William Haggas-trained Manaar would be noteworthy.

COSMO BROWN - KINDLY QUEEN - MYTHICAL BAY

Race Preview: Kindly Queen continues to find steady progress and looks a real player having struck the woodwork at Windsor. Andrew Balding saddles two, of which Mythical Bay appears to be the yards leading hope, but COSMO BROWN might be the value. The Ghaiyyath colt didn't show much in his first two starts but took a big leap forward to finish third when upped to 10 furlongs in a Leicester novice. He tackles further this time around and from an opening mark of 72, it would come as no surprise were he to find further improvement.

Race Preview: Collateral Damage fetched 280,000 euros at the sales in September and merits the utmost respect for a team that typically do well with their youngsters, but experience can win the day for WILBUR. The son of Kingman was far from inexpensive himself when bought for 160,000 euros, and his Newbury introduction was full of promise. A step up in trip is sure to benefit and he is expected to progress. Leave The Bag In heads the remainder.

Race Preview: Despite having to shoulder a penalty, a confident vote goes to NURSIA. Kevin Ryan's charge never figured on his debut at Ayr, but he took a big step forward to score at Newcastle in January. The runner-up has since won twice and is now rated 77, so he should be more than capable with that in mind. Two Commanders and Lady Gormire are others to note.
