RACE 1: BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 2) (2YO ONLY) (FROM YORK RACE 1)

CUT A DASH - VARZI - FANTASY FORCE

Race Preview: CUT A DASH has an appealing cross of speed and stamina in his pedigree and he could have a bright future. With that in mind, Richard Hannon's colt tops the shortlist. Varzi's trainer has an above-average strike-rate with juveniles and this half-brother to a mile winner in Australia must be taken seriously, although the application of a tongue-tie for his debut is a slight concern. Fantasy Force and Courseyoudo also merit betting checks.

Race Preview: William Haggas sent out the 2021 and 2022 winners of this race and can add to the tally with the progressive KLASSLEADER. Last seen when a close second to Sing Us A Song, the son of Lope De Vega can reverse the places with his old rival over this shorter trip and armed with a 2lb pull. The class-dropping Plage De Havre struggled in a Listed event at Kempton on his seasonal bow, but is a key player back in a handicap. Paddy The Squire is the pick of the rest.

The Geoff Oldroyd-trained entire has a touch of class and this could be a good starting point for his turf campaign. Pilgrim, Strike Red and Sondad are just a trio of many others with each-way credentials in a wide-open event.

Race Preview: AMERICAN AFFAIR progressed through the handicap ranks before springing something of a shock to land the King Charles III at Royal Ascot last season, and Jim Goldie's speedster might be worth chancing on his seasonal reappearance. Time For Sandals made a satisfactory return in the Abernant last month and can be expected to have a big say, along with Haydock Sprint Cup one-two Big Mojo and Kind Of Blue. Aramram is still on an upward curve and might also be thereabouts.

Race Preview: The Gosdens won this two years on the spin with Emily Upjohn in 2022 and Soul Sister in 2023, and their representative LEGACY LINK can enhance that record. The dual-Oaks entrant was last seen finishing fourth in the Fillies' Mile at Newmarket but looks sure to progress over middle-distances this term. The likes of Felicitas, Sea The Storm and Moments Of Joy are others likely to find real improvement this year, but the Gosdens' filly could have too much if returning at her best.

HASBRO MARKET - AL NAJASHI - PASSING THOUGHT

Race Preview: With five consecutive victories to his name, Al Najashi has proved a revelation since entering handicaps at Southwell in January. Although the son of Territories has yet to score on turf, there isn't any reason to believe that he won't go well again. That said, a 9lb higher mark does demand another career best from Ollie Sangster's colt and preference is for the unexposed HASBRO MARKET, who offered plenty of encouragement on his second-placed seasonal/handicap bow at Wetherby last month. Reopposing winner Passing Thought isn't easily dismissed, but more is needed off 2lb worse terms with the selection.

Race Preview: El Lambo and Martha Brown were well held in their previous starts and the newcomers hold more intrigue. Time Saxon Warrior represents a yard that have already struck with a juvenile this season and is high on the shortlist. Preference, however, is for TRIBAL APPEARANCE, who is bred to be speedy and this could be a good starting point. Romeo Guest ticks the right boxes on paper and support in the betting would be persuasive.

Race Preview: DARZAH, who cost 375,000gns as a yearling, made a promising debut when fifth behind a potentially useful filly at Newmarket last month. The daughter of Dubawi can be expected to be wiser and gets the vote based on potential. The progressive Vitality rates a serious danger on the back of a good second at Epsom, while the four-year-old Mobberley Rose commands respect after her belated winning debut at Wolverhampton.
