ARDISIA - TAMATHER - SUPREME DANCER

Race Preview: ARDISIA has a couple of significant early-closing entries and can boost his chances of being a acceptor if he copes with the penalty imposed for his debut success at Musselburgh 12 days ago. The manner in which the son of Ardad won that race suggests the 7lb burden is very manageable at this stage. Tamather met all sorts of trouble on his racecourse bow but should be wiser for the experience. Supreme Dancer and Awraad, whose yard won last year's sole division of this race, are the most notable debutants.

The betting should be informative, however, and the likes of Under The Radar and Bravo Hotel are others to keep an eye on.
