**RACE 1:           MIDNITE A NEXT GENERATION BETTING APP CLASSIFIED STAKES (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS) (FROM LINGFIELD RACE 2)**

**COLORS OF FREEDOM - NAD ALSHIBA SNOW - FOREST GUNNER**

Race Preview: The majority of these have something to prove at present and it's hard to get away from the claims of COLORS OF FREEDOM. The six-year-old has filled the runner-up spot on her last two outings and an eighth career victory may beckon. Nad Alshiba Snow and Forest Gunner may fare better entering classified company, with the former rating the biggest danger.

3	FOREST GUNNER	A winner at 5f on the all-weather. Finished 7l behind Gogo Yubari when fifth of 6 at 7-1 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 5f earlier this month.
4	GLOBAL EFFORT	Winner of five races from 5f to 6f including 4 wins on the all-weather (1 PO). Beaten 3 1/2l behind Midnight Call at 22-1 when seventh of 9 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 5f earlier this month.
5	NAD ALSHIBA SNOW	Placed twice in 15 starts. Finished 2 3/4l behind Gustav Graves when fifth of 7 at 5-1 on her latest outing at Wolverhampton over 5f in December last year.
6	ROGUE ENDEAVOUR	Placed once in 19 starts. Beaten 15l behind Love Your Work at 66-1 when seventh of 10 on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m in October last year.
7	SULTAN OF OJ	Placed once in 14 starts. Finished 3l behind Midnight Call when sixth of 9 at 3-1 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 5f earlier this month.

**RACE 2:           BET 10 GET 40 WITH BETMGM FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (3YO PLUS) (FROM LINGFIELD RACE 3)**

**LOTUS - LOMA EXPRESS - CHAMAS**

Race Preview: Loma Express shaped better than the beaten distance may suggest when finishing fifth at Newcastle and she must enter the reckoning on her stable bow. However, LOTUS wasn't disgraced on her opening fifth at Kempton and may find the necessary improvement to open her account. Ralph Beckett has his string in fantastic form and market support for debutant Chamas would need to be explored.

5	LOTUS	Finished 4 1/2l behind Botagoz when fifth of 8 at 14-1 on her racecourse debut at Kempton over 7f in December last year.
6	STOLE MY HEART	Unplaced in both starts. Finished 8l behind Botagoz when sixth of 8 at 40-1 on her latest outing at Kempton over 7f in December last year.
7	VENTANA	Half-sister to Secret Angel, won three times at 6f. Beaten 9l behind Inis Mor at 40-1 when eighth of 10 on her racecourse debut at Newmarket over 7f (good to firm) in August last year.

**RACE 3: BEST ODDS GUARANTEED AT BETMGM HANDICAP (DIV 1) (CLASS 6) (3YO ONLY) (FROM LINGFIELD RACE 4)**

**GILES GLORY - CHILLICONCARNEIGH - HOVE RANGER**

Race Preview: A confident vote goes to GILES GLORY, who returned from some time off the track to win comfortably over 7f here recently. That success could in part be attributed to the application of a first-time visor/tongue-tie combination (retained) and should they work the oracle again, the 6lb penalty is unlikely to prevent another bold bid. Wolverhampton runner-up Chilliconcarneigh looks the biggest threat, while a market check is advised with regards to handicap debutant Hove Ranger.

3	URBAN LAW	Yet to place in four starts. Beaten 9l behind dead-heaters Aneirin's Sword and Three Socks On at 18-1 when last of 8 on her latest outing at Chelmsford City over 1m earlier this month.
4	HOVE RANGER	Unplaced in all three starts. Finished 6l behind Marseillan when sixth of 10 at 150-1 on his latest outing here over 7f in December last year.
5	LADY BIRGMA	Unplaced in all four starts. Finished 10l behind Crown The Future when sixth of 9 at 10-1 on her latest outing at Wolverhampton over 7f in November last year.

**HARDSTYLE - ATHENIAN SPIRIT - AKRIVOS**

Race Preview: Connections of Athenian Spirit will be hopeful of a timely form boost from Giles Glory (runs in the first division) given that he finished second to him last time. However, he's been a weak finisher over 7f and that has to raise some doubts regarding his stamina at the mile. With that in mind, preference is for HARDSTYLE. The Blue Point gelding was far from disgraced over the extended mile at Wolverhampton latest and any improvement in a contest of this nature may suffice. Akrivos is another to consider.

**GOGO YUBARI - HINT OF HUMOUR - WOODHAY WHISPER**

Race Preview: There are few in better form at present than GOGO YUBARI, who arrives having rattled off a quick-fire hat-trick last week. Her latest success would suggest there is still something left under the bonnet and even a whopping 15lb penalty might not halt her winning run. If anyone can get close, though, it might be Hint Of Humour, who is much better off at the weights having finished second to the selection on Saturday. It is hard to knock Woodhay Whisper's consistency and she is expected to be thereabouts at the finish.

3	FAUSTUS	Winner of seven races at 5f including 2 wins on the all-weather. Finished 7l behind Gogo Yubari when fifth of 7 at 7-2 on his latest outing over this course and distance earlier this month.
4	BEAUMADIER	He has won three times at 5f including 2 wins on the all-weather. Third of 8 behind Emperor's Son beaten 1 3/4l at 4-1 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 5f earlier this month.
5	WOODHAY WHISPER	Successful twice at 6f on the all-weather (1 PO). Third of 7 behind Combustion beaten 1 1/4l at 9-2 on her latest outing here over 6f earlier this month.
6	MICK'S SPIRIT	Has won nine races at 5f on polytrack. Finished 4 1/2l behind Gogo Yubari when fourth of 7 at 11-2 on his latest outing over this course and distance earlier this month.
