RACE 1: BRITISH STALLIONS STUDS EBF NURSERY (CLASS 4) (2YO ONLY)

SOCA STAR - ROGUE SUPREMACY - BLEEP TEST

Race Preview: A small but competitive nursery in which marginal preference is for SOCA STAR. The daughter of Starman has yet to score but she's posted a number of fine efforts, most notably when third behind Venetian Sun at Carlisle in May. A mark of 74 looks fair and the addition of first-time cheekpieces could eke out further improvement. Rogue Supremacy will find this less taxing than the two Listed events he has contested recently, and the admirably consistent Bleep Test should not be far away either.

4	SOCA STAR	Foaled 5 Feb. Placed once in four starts. Beaten 1/2l by Golden Palace when second of 8 at 6-4fav on her latest outing at Beverley over 5f (good to firm) earlier this month.

RACE 2: PHOENIX DRILLING GROUND INVESTIGATION HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (3YO PLUS)

MISS RAINBOW - SKI ANGEL - PINPOINT

Race Preview: Now three from three since being fitted with a visor, MISS RAINBOW remains well treated from 3lb higher than last month's Newcastle triumph and is taken to complete a four-timer. Recent Musselburgh scorer Ski Angel should give the selection plenty to think about, providing stall one isn't too much of an inconvenience. Pinpoint and Kyber Crystal are two others who could have a say.

2	KYBER CRYSTAL	She has won four times at 5f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft. Beaten 1/2l by Pinpoint when second of 6 at 13-2 on her latest outing over this course and distance (good) last month.
3	REFUGE	Winner of seven races at 5f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. Finished 6l behind Snow Berry when sixth of 8 at 9-2 on his latest outing at Nottingham over 5f (good) last month.
4	LADY OF THE GARR	Successful twice at 5f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 10l behind Mrs Trump at 12-1 when 16th of 18 on her latest outing at Thirsk over 6f (good) earlier this month. Has won at Wetherby and Newcastle this season.
5	THE VOOMINATOR	Unplaced in all five starts. Third of 7 behind Art Of Fox beaten 2 3/4l at 33-1 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 5f last month.

6	PINPOINT	He has won three times at 5f on good and good to soft ground. Finished 3l behind Stormy Pearl when fourth of 5 at 5-2 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good) earlier this month.
7	SKI ANGEL	Winner of five races at 5f on ground varying from good to soft. Won on her latest outing when 9-4fav at Musselburgh over 5f (good) earlier this month, beating Mrs Bagerran by a neck.
8	SIXCOR	Winner of seven races from 5f to 6f on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft and on the all-weather. Third of 7 behind Novamay beaten 7l at 9-1 on his latest outing at Ayr over 6f (good) earlier this month.
9	SALI CINNAMON	Yet to place in four starts. Beaten 4 1/2l behind Ski Angel at 66-1 when seventh of 8 on her latest outing at Musselburgh over 5f (good) earlier this month.

RACE 3: RACING TV RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 5) (3YO TO 5YO)

SILENT CITY - BRIELLE - WADACRE MAESTRO

Race Preview: Brielle kept on well into second over 1m4f at Thirsk so, although respected, dropping in trip might not play to her strengths. With that in mind, preference is for the penalised SILENT CITY, who was able to build on an encouraging debut performance to score in fine style at Windsor. Zacharia Clarke takes off a handy 7lb and Roger Varian's filly could prove tough to beat. Wadacre Maestro heads the remainder.

2	SILENT CITY	Won on her latest outing when 11-10fav at Windsor over 1m (good to firm) last month, beating Gennadius by 4l.
3	WADACRE MAESTRO	Unplaced in both starts. Finished 4 1/2l behind City Of Poets when fourth of 12 at 100-1 on his latest outing at Wetherby over 7f (good to firm) last month.
4	ANGELARDO	Dam a lightly raced maiden. Well beaten at 40-1 behind Valiancy when last of 7 on his racecourse debut here over 1m 3f (good) last month.
5	BRIELLE	Placed once in two starts. Beaten 1 1/4l by Ghaiyya when second of 6 at 2-1 on her latest outing at Thirsk over 1m 4f (good to firm) last month.
6	STORM ON JURA	Unplaced in both starts. Finished 13l behind Danger Bay when sixth of 11 at 250-1 on her latest outing here over 1m 1f (good) last month.
7	BRING HER HOME	Unplaced in both starts. Well beaten at 200-1 behind Suite Francaise when last of 5 on her latest outing at Haydock over 1m (good to firm) in May.
8	PRECIOUS SAPPHIRE	Half-sister to Cool Athlete, won five times at 7f and 1m. Beaten 18l behind Flame Of Forest at 150-1 when last of 11 on her racecourse debut at Carlisle over 7f (good to firm) in May.

RACE 4: WELLMAN CARS PRIVATE HIRE ALMADA MILE HANDICAP (CLASS 2) (3YO PLUS)

SALLAAL - THEORYOFEVERYTHING - RHYTHM MASTER

Race Preview: A taking winner over C&D on just his third career outing when last seen in May, SALLAAL could be well treated off 97 on his handicap debut and he can take this en route to bigger things later in the season. Theoryofeverything may not be the most consistent but he looked good when scoring at Ayr, although running off a mark of 97 represents a career high for the five-year-old. Rhythm Master has performed with plenty of credit the last twice and cannot be ruled out with Sam James back in the saddle.

1	BRAVE EMPEROR	Has won 11 races from 5f to 10m on ground varying from good to firm to heavy and on the all-weather. Finished 10l behind Interstellar when sixth of 8 on his latest outing in the Group 3 Premio Carlo Vittadini Stakes - Group 3 at San Siro over 1m (soft) last month.
2	ENGLISH OAK	He has won three times from 7f to 1m on good to firm and soft ground. Beaten 20l behind Never So Brave at 5-1 when 25th of 27 on his latest outing at Ascot over 7f (good to firm) last month.
3	THEORYOFEVERYTHING	He has won four times from 7f to 1m 1f on good to soft and soft ground. Won on his latest outing when 7-4fav at Ayr over 1m (good to soft) earlier this month, beating Kelpie Grey by 1 1/4l. Carries a 5lb penalty today for that success.
4	SALLAAL	Successful at 7f and 1m on good to firm and soft ground. Won on his latest outing when 1-3fav over this course and distance (good to firm) in May, beating Arctic Grey by 3l.
5	RHYTHM MASTER	Successful at 6f and 7f on good to soft ground and on the all-weather, but last win was over three years ago. Beaten 1 1/4l by Castle Stuart when second of 6 at 10-1 on his latest outing at Musselburgh over 1m 1f (good) earlier this month.
6	SAILTHISSHIPALONE	A winner at 7f on good ground. Third of 16 behind On The River beaten a head at 25-1 on his latest outing at Carlisle over 1m (soft) last month.
