(FROM PONTEFRACT RACE 1)

JOLLY GOOD FELLOWS - MARGARET'S PEARL - SEA MIRAGE

Race Preview: The penny dropped for JOLLY GOOD FELLOWS at Wolverhampton and she made late headway into third. She is bred to be a quick, early type and can take the necessary step forward. On the same day as the selection's introduction, Too Many Spirits made slightly less of an impression at Thirsk but, again, the experience won't be lost on him. Margaret's Pearl offered encouragement with her debut fourth at Wolverhampton, while Sea Mirage and Claret And Blues are the most interesting newcomers.

Race Preview: Some interesting newcomers go to post, not least SIOUXPERB, whose price rose from 90,000gns as a foal to 110,000gns less than a year later. He is bred to hit the ground running and his trainer is already on the two-year-old scoresheet this season. Viking Barbie made 78,000 euros as a yearling and is another whose pedigree is predominately speed-based. Hamdani Mokhater's dam was a classy sprinter so he must be considered closely too.

LADY YOUMZAIN - TOWN QUEEN - ELEMMA

Race Preview: LADY YOUMZAIN made a sparkling beginning to her career when slamming a now 81-rated opponent by five lengths at Beverley. The further she went, the better she looked so the extra furlong should play to her strengths even more. In the same ownership, Town Queen commands attention on debut. The daughter of Blue Point cost 160,000 euros as a yearling, while Elemma wasn't that much cheaper and is another interesting first-timer. Reader was promising at Goodwood, but then didn't seem to handle the Chelmsford Polytrack.

Race Preview: Fanciulla Del West split a couple of subsequent winners when third at Newcastle, although the form still isn't that strong. BRILLIANT STAR's second at the same venue hasn't worked out too well either, but the beautifully-bred daughter of Cracksman almost overcame her inexperience when getting within half a length of victory. Out of the stable's Irish Oaks heroine Star Catcher, she will relish the rise from a mile. Kenkelly is just about the pick of the debutants.

Race Preview: Reciprocated was highly tried after winning his first two starts, only to come up well short, and he ended 2025 on a low note at Ayr. The form of that nursery is better than it looked at the time, but CAPE ASHIZURI is still preferred. The Quinns' son of St Mark's Basilica has also been thrown in at the deep end and although second at even-money at Redcar when last seen, the winner holds a 2000 Guineas entry and could be smart. Alaminos is well related and expected to improve as a three-year-old.

The six-year-old made a pleasing start for Adam Kirby when second over 7f at Chelmsford and he can cope with a 3lb rise to get his head back in front.

He is now bidding to complete a seven-timer but the return to turf might find him out and, with that in mind, GREAT gets the nod. Sam England's gelding showed more when sixth at Thirsk earlier in the month and the booking of Oisin Orr is noteworthy. Diamont Katie is another to consider.

Space Bear has already been competitive off this mark and is one to be interested in, while Eighththreeone sprung a 20/1 surprise at Southwell earlier in the month and isn't ruled out either.

However, the claims of GRABAJABBA are difficult to ignore. Having made the frame on his most recent outings at Southwell and Doncaster, the five-year-old makes plenty of appeal off only 1lb higher. Candonomore and Miletus can fight it out for the minor honours.

Race Preview: Crown Inn To Win has been much improved since stepping up to this distance, claiming silver medals at Southwell and here. He surely won't remain a maiden for too much longer, but the Gosdens won't have had many inmates rated just 59 so ITSONLYROCKANDROLL is too tempting to ignore. The daughter of Pinatubo cost 105,000gns as a yearling and although she has shown little in three qualifying runs, much better is expected now handicapping. Corduroy finished alongside Crown Inn To Win over C&D so has to enter the equation too.

Shalaa Asker is another reliable sprinter and was a few places ahead of Phoenix Beach when pipped here most recently. Cheekpieces don't need to prompt too much improvement from Binadham, while Em Four is holding his form well.
