RACE 1: MIDNITE ARE UPPING THE BETTING GAME APPRENTICE HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS)

MOUNT RUAPEHU - TUSCAN POINT - BULLINGTON BRY

Race Preview: Tuscan Point provided Adam Kirby with the perfect start to his training career when scoring over C&D in some style. That said, he is essentially 15lb higher when factoring in his rider's claim from last week, and that might give the edge to MOUNT RUAPEHU. Only raised 2lb for his success on the same card here, the six-year-old can confirm form with Bullington Bry, who finished third.

4	AMERJEET	A winner at 5f on polytrack. Finished 2l behind Mount Ruapehu when fifth of 11 at 10-3fav on his latest outing over this course and distance earlier this month.
5	ARDADDY	A winner at 7f on the all-weather. Finished 7l behind Pearly Squirrel when sixth of 8 at 9-4fav on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 7f earlier this month.
6	UP THE MONK	Successful twice at 6f on the all-weather (1 PO). Beaten 11l behind Tuscan Point at 10-1 when eighth of 11 on his latest outing over this course and distance earlier this month.
7	MOONHALL LASS	Placed in five of 22 starts. Beaten 11l behind Winemaker at 25-1 when 13th of 14 on her latest outing at Dundalk over 6f in January. Having her first run for a new stable today, previously with Patrick J F Murphy in Ireland.

RACE 2: WIN 250,000 WITH BETMGM'S GOLDEN GOALS HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS)

RIBSTON PIPPIN - FIFTY SENT - HERETIC

Race Preview: Fifty Sent has won both starts this month over C&D in classified events, but reverting to handicap company off a 4lb higher mark might prove to be his undoing. Therefore, the vote goes to RIBSTON PIPPIN. The four-year-old benefited from the return to a mile here just before Christmas and it wouldn't be a surprise if he had more to offer. Heretic completes the shortlist.

3	RIBSTON PIPPIN	Successful twice at 1m including a win on the all-weather. A winner at 8-1 over this course and distance on his latest outing in December last year, beating Imola by 1 1/4l.
4	TRAISS FLUORS	Has won 13 races from 7f to 1m 1f including 7 wins on the all-weather (2 PO). Beaten 4 1/2l behind Operation Gimcrack at 12-1 when seventh of 10 on his latest outing at Newcastle over 7f last month.
5	MR FUSTIC	Winner of five races from 1m to 1m 1f on the all-weather (2 PO). Third of 8 behind Fast Bullet beaten 2 3/4l at 11-2 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 1m last month.
6	VOLENDAM	Placed in seven of 15 starts. Finished 6l behind Fast Bullet when sixth of 8 at 9-4fav on her latest outing at Chelmsford City over 1m last month.

RACE 3: ALWAYS GAMBLE RESPONSIBLY AT BETMGM RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (DIV 1) (CLASS 4) (3YO TO 5YO)

TIMBER TWELVE - SAINT OF THE SEA - FLASH KOZO

Race Preview: TIMBER TWELVE was a surprise winner on his racecourse debut at Kempton in September. This doesn't look the strongest of novice events on paper and Michael Bell's gelding is expected to follow up under a penalty. Saint Of The Sea stepped forward from his first start when runner-up over C&D last month and is likely to be the main danger. Flash Kozo and Clatford appear best of the remainder.

RACE 4: ALWAYS GAMBLE RESPONSIBLY AT BETMGM RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (DIV 2) (CLASS 4) (3YO TO 5YO)

FILLY EILISH - PORTMAN BLUE - TOMMO'S GINJANINJA

Race Preview: Although not quite at his best when finishing fifth at Newcastle recently, Portman Blue's previous thirds give him leading claims. However, Wolverhampton runner-up FILLY EILISH is heading in the right direction and, in receipt of weight from the majority of the field, she edges the vote. Tommo's Ginjaninja should appreciate this longer distance and may land the bronze medal, ahead of Welbury.

VELVET RED - LITTLE MISS INDIA - GREEN SKY

Race Preview: Green Sky returned to the Flat with a decent effort at 100/1 when fourth at Lingfield and she could fight for a place off 1lb lower. Little Miss India won narrowly at Wolverhampton last month and can go well despite an added 4lb, but VELVET RED is preferred. She won easily enough over C&D last week, and the rise in class off 6lb higher may not be sufficient to stop her from following up.
