**RACE 1: ICL HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (4YO PLUS) (FROM HAYDOCK RACE 1)**

**TREASURE ISLANDS - DREAMS ADOZEN - FLEURMAN**

Race Preview: Dreams Adozen signed off her five-year-old campaign with victory at Nottingham in October and she has to be respected on her return to action. However, TREASURE ISLANDS made every yard of the running to score by a length at Ripon last month and competes off only a 3lb higher figure. This represents just his third start in handicap company and he looks the one to beat. Fleurman completes the shortlist.

**RACE 2: PITCH PERFECT EBF MAIDEN STAKES (GBB/GBBPLUS RACE) (CLASS 3) (3YO PLUS) (FROM HAYDOCK RACE 2)**

**SCARLET LEGEND - MOONRUNNER - HUMPHREY**

Race Preview: SCARLET LEGEND shaped with plenty of promise when hitting the woodwork on his introduction at Salisbury and is likely to have lots of improvement in him. Provided Andrew Balding's colt goes the right way after that display, he will prove hard to beat. Moonrunner finished third at Southwell and should appreciate this slight rise in distance. Humphrey is a well-related son of Pinatubo and warrants a market check.

**RACE 3: UNSUNG HEROES FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (3YO PLUS) (FROM HAYDOCK RACE 3)**

**SECRET OF LIFE - POINTE BLEU - SHUSHU**

Race Preview: SECRET OF LIFE beat an experienced rival when making a winning debut at Wolverhampton last August and could have lots more to offer this season. With any amount of improvement to come, Ralph Beckett's filly looks the way to go. More was expected of Pointe Bleu when only fourth on her introduction at Newmarket, but it wouldn't be a surprise to see her take a big step forward. Any market confidence behind newcomer Shushu would be interesting.

**LION OF MALI - EUPHONIA - EDUARDO CALDERON**

Race Preview: Since going handicapping, LION OF MALI has won three of his five starts and finished second in the other two, and made a successful return to turf when accounting for Eduardo Calderon at Leicester. He showed excellent resolution to justify short-priced favouritism and has only been raised 2lb. Euphonia seems to be much happier on grass and had three subsequent winners trailing in her wake when running out an emphatic winner at the same venue. Tekitoff also arrives on the back of a breakthrough victory, although that Doncaster form isn't as strong.

Race Preview: CHARTED COURSE was a 100,000gns yearling, but his price rocketed to 450,000gns after he strutted his stuff at the Craven Breeze-Ups. A half-brother to the high-class Mujtaba, connections will be looking for some immediate return on their substantial investment. Walt changed hands for 82,000gns at the same sales last month and is also expected to hit the ground running. Regal Tiger isn't bred to be quite as quick, but the son of Kingman still boasts a nice pedigree and must be taken into consideration.

The hat-trick seeking From The Hip holds an obvious chance, but it's OBSIDIAN VERSE who appeals most. James Fanshawe's gelding made his second start in handicap company a winning one at Southwell and can follow up.

Race Preview: BRUMMELL produced a better performance after a wind operation when finishing third in a class 3 event at Doncaster. The son of Dandy Man has kindly been eased 1lb for that comeback effort and can take advantage of this drop in grade. Three-time course winner Trilby is a player based on his second at Beverley two starts ago, while Isle Of Lismore is another to keep an eye on.

Race Preview: Ariane Sky caught the eye running on when the race was all over at Bath and will relish the extra yardage, but she comes up against some interesting newcomers. GREEN TITAN is a half-brother to Tropical Island, who was successful in Listed company. His dam won three times over 5f as a juvenile so he might have more speed than Issy's Gift, an Ardad half-brother to plenty of winners including the smart Galeron. Benefacta is also worth a look.

**EM FOUR - EL BUFALO - MARCHING MAC**

Race Preview: EM FOUR appears to thrive on his racing and, following a successful spring, he returned to turf to perform well for third at Salisbury. That form has been boosted by a subsequent victory for the runner-up and, if he can get to the lead, Jamie Osborne's speedster will take some catching. El Bufalo is more at home on an artificial surface, although he went into a few notebooks after his Ascot sixth so must be feared. Marching Mac will relish the return to grass.

**BOSTON MAX - FOREVER GLAMOROUS - STOCK MARKET**

Race Preview: BOSTON MAX is Gordon Elliott's first Flat runner at Chepstow and the hint must be taken. After showing precious little in maiden company as a juvenile, the son of Bungle Inthejungle showed the benefit of a gelding operation when returning to make a successful handicap debut at Dundalk. He is 7lb higher, but should have plenty more to offer. Stock Market is edging closer to a breakthrough triumph, although the return to the minimum trip might not be ideal so Forever Glamorous, who was nailed close home over 6f at Windsor, could be the bigger danger.

Race Preview: Romanovich returned to turf with a placed effort at Bath and is likely to be competitive off 1lb lower, while course winner Spirit Of The Bay commands respect on her first run since October. That said, OPENING BAT gets the vote. Harry Charlton's gelding was mostly consistent during 2025 and the booking of Billy Loughnane, who won on the son of Bated Breath at Kempton 12 months ago, has to be seen as a positive.
