RACE 1: RACINGTV.COM APPRENTICE HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS)

MISS RAINBOW - FORTUNATE STAR - TOMMY MCJOHN

Race Preview: Fortunate Star has posted several creditable efforts in defeat since returning to handicap company and he should give another good account. However, the six-year-old may come up just short once more, with MISS RAINBOW edging the vote. Tracy Waggott's mare arrives on the back of a course third over 6f and a drop back in distance may prove fruitful. Tommy McJohn is also of interest on his stable bow for Adrian Keatley.

4	NACHO NACHO NACHO	A winner at 7f on the all-weather. Finished 7l behind Cargin Bhui when sixth of 10 at 7-2 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 6f in February.
5	MISS RAINBOW	She has won four times from 5f to 7f on good ground and on the all-weather. Third of 8 behind Keldeo beaten 1 1/2l at 5-1 on her latest outing here over 6f (good) earlier this month.
6	FORTUNATE STAR	Winner of seven races at 5f on good and soft ground and on the all-weather. Third of 10 behind Invitorio beaten 1 1/4l at 9-2 on his latest outing at Southwell over 5f earlier this month.
7	LUCIUS AURELIUS	Placed in five of 16 starts. Beaten 9l behind Jojo Rabbit at 13-2 when 10th of 13 on his latest outing at Pontefract over 5f (good to soft) earlier this month.
8	BARMYBLADE	He has won three times from 5f to 6f on good ground. Beaten 10l behind Juan Les Pins at 40-1 when 14th of 15 on his latest outing at Thirsk over 6f (good) earlier this month.

RACE 2: BET AT RACINGTV.COM HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (3YO ONLY)

ROKOKURA BELLE - SOCA STAR - NAANA'S SHADOW

Race Preview: A switch to more aggressive tactics saw ROTOKURA BELLE secure a first turf victory over C&D and she gave the impression that there could be more in the locker. A 3lb nudge up the ratings looks workable and she gets the vote over the returning Soca Star, who ended her juvenile campaign with a respectable third at Wolverhampton and looks feasibly treated reverting to handicap company. Naana's Shadow is the pick of the remainder.

5	ROKOKURA BELLE	Successful twice at 5f on good ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 9-1 over this course and distance (good) on her latest outing earlier this month, beating Empress Olivia by a neck.
6	PARODA DIVA	A winner at 7f on good ground. Beaten 5l behind Keldeo at 22-1 when seventh of 8 on her latest outing here over 6f (good) earlier this month.
7	MORETONS	Placed once in ten starts. Beaten 2 1/4l behind Rotokura Belle at 50-1 when seventh of 10 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good) earlier this month.
8	PEGGY BOO	Unplaced in all four starts. Beaten 20l behind Southern Warrior at 28-1 when last of 7 on her latest outing at Newcastle over 6f last month.

RACE 3: DOWNLOAD THE RACEDAY READY APP RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (3YO TO 5YO)

CRANACHAN - LORD - MYTHICAL VALENTINE

Race Preview: Although worn down in the closing stages at Kempton, CRANACHAN lost little in finishing second. The son of Cracksman should have no issue debuting on turf and compensation could be on the cards. Mythical Valentine was a length behind the selection in third and must enter calculations, although a bigger threat may emerge from Lord, who boasts a Listed hurdle triumph at Aintree in December on his CV.

RACE 4: EBF FILLIES' RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 5) (3YO TO 5YO)

GOT THE BOOTY - STELLA LUCENTE - BORJINA

Race Preview: GOT THE BOOTY stepped forward from her debut when runner-up at Kempton in September and she appeared to improve again, despite being turned over, at Southwell earlier in the month. She sets a clear standard and it would be disappointing if Tom Ward's filly couldn't get off the mark at the fourth time of asking. Stella Lucente is the obvious threat based on her pair of runner-up efforts on the all-weather, while Borjina is open to progression after her sole juvenile outing when fourth at Newcastle.

RACE 5: EVERY RACE LIVE ON RACING TV HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (4YO PLUS)

VINCE LE PRINCE - EVOCATIVE SPARK - ASIAN JOURNEY

Race Preview: Evocative Spark (first) got the better of VINCE LE PRINCE (second) here in October and did the same a fortnight ago. However, the handicapper left the runner-up alone and a 4lb swing, along with that being his first run of the season, is reason enough to believe that the form can be reversed. Asian Journey had been running with credit on the all-weather before a solid return to turf at Doncaster, while the veteran Roundhay Park is capable of being in the mix.

7	CROCODILE POWER	Winner of seven races from 6f to 7f on good and soft ground and on the all-weather. Third of 12 behind Evocative Spark beaten 5l at 28-1 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good) earlier this month.
8	ROUNDHAY PARK	Has won 13 races from 5f to 7f on ground varying from good to firm to soft. Finished 6l behind Evocative Spark when fifth of 11 at 28-1 on his latest outing over this course and distance (soft) in October last year.
9	SIMPLY BLUE	Successful at 6f and 7f on the all-weather. A winner at 7-2 at Wolverhampton over 6f on his latest outing earlier this month, beating Forever Noah by a neck.

RACE 6: RACING TV PROFITS RETURNED TO RACING HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (4YO PLUS)

ROSENPUR - DORNEY LAKE - ABERAMA GOLD

Race Preview: Dorney Lake took a step back in the right direction when third at Southwell and will capitalise on his plummeting rating sooner rather than later. Similar comments apply to Aberama Gold, but a chance is taken on the fitness of ROSENPUR. The six-year-old's last two efforts on turf resulted in minor placings here and although most effective at 5f, he is good enough at this trip. The complexion of this sprint will change if Yorkshire Glory and, to a lesser extent, No Return turn up after Tuesday's Pontefract engagements.

RACE 7: RACING AGAIN 11TH MAY HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS)

FREE PIC - REGAL GLORY - ROCK ARMOUR

Race Preview: FREE PIC numbered Stellarmasterpiece and Nakatomi among her victims when making a successful return to turf over a mile and a half here. The five-year-old saw out her race really well so can confirm her superiority over this trip off a 4lb higher mark. Rock Armour made the frame in the second division of that contest a couple of weeks ago but the primary threat might emerge in the shape of Regal Glory, who proved her stamina when runner-up at Wolverhampton.

7	NAKATOMI	Placed once in 17 starts. Finished 6l behind Free Pic when fifth of 10 at 40-1 on his latest outing here over 1m 4f (good) earlier this month.
