RACE 1: HERE COME THE GIRLS EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 3) (2YO ONLY) (FROM BEVERLEY RACE 1)

LADY CAROLINE LAMB - LITTLE LADY KAREN - FERN CLYDE

Race Preview: After a promising debut over 7f at Kempton, LADY CAROLINE LAMB should be suited by the stiffer nature of this track and can get off the mark at the second time of asking. Rogue Passion ran green on her debut at Catterick but should also be wiser and have more to offer, while Fern Clyde commands respect, despite picking up a 4lb penalty after breaking her maiden at Pontefract.

Race Preview: Punchbowl Flyer has to be respected following his recent Chepstow success, but a 4lb penalty demands more from the veteran. As a result, preference is for LOHOOBB, who has been running well but struggling get home over 7f of late. Down in trip here, Owen Burrows' colt could be hard to stop. Others to note are Grey Horizon and On Edge.

Race Preview: With five wins in 2026 already, Roaring Ralph is a credit to connections and must be on the shortlist. The downside is that flatter surfaces appear to suit him best and this uphill finish might not be ideal. A four-time course winner, Coolree has nothing to prove in that regard and he could have a bigger say back here. Nevertheless, preference is for THIS FARH, who had a length to spare over the latter when he won over C&D last month and is dependable enough to uphold the form.

Sorted has been running well without getting his head in front this year and returned from a small break when fourth at Wolverhampton last Tuesday. He can enter the reckoning, along with Scarfo and Mooretown Lad.
