RACE 1: FITZDARES HARROWAYS HANDICAP (CLASS 2) (3YO ONLY) (FROM GOODWOOD RACE 1)

WECHAAD - STARTLED - GOODWOOD GALAXY

Race Preview: Goodwood Galaxy may have been targeted here and although well beaten at Sandown after trying to make the running, he races off 3lb lower and drops back a furlong. The hat-trick seeking Startled goes from strength to strength but an added 7lb and a rise in class could find him out, and WECHAAD is preferred. Third in the Horris Hill last season, the son of Oasis Dream makes plenty of appeal back in handicap company.

Race Preview: It's been some time since Friendly Soul's win in the Prix de l'Opera but connections persist and she will undoubtedly be a threat to all if returning at anywhere near her best. However, although disappointing at Cork last month, WEMIGHTAKEDLONGWAY might be worth keeping on side. The daughter of Australia held her own at the highest level for much of last year and is expected to do considerably better with that effort under her belt. Cheshire Dancer could go well at a price.

Race Preview: Tom Marquand has picked up the ride on Charlie Appleby's Del Maro and although well beaten in the Chester Vase after a slow start, he could do better here. SAXON STREET arrives unbeaten after comfortable wins at Chelmsford and Epsom and the fact that he remains entered in the Derby suggests the son of Saxon Warrior should go well here. Golden Story was third at Chester and could make the frame once again.

Race Preview: LANGSTONE shrugged off a penalty to follow up his Doncaster triumph at Kempton and looks a real player now sent handicapping. Clive Cox has his string in excellent order and although this is wide open, his Mayson gelding gets the vote. Wetherby novice winner Princling should go well, as should the progressive Laureate Crown. Lighting Thunder was workmanlike when landing the odds at Nottingham but he could take a step forward in first-time cheekpieces, while others worth considering include Jamestown and Blue Courvoisier.

Race Preview: Wondervision saw market support on her debut before finishing third at Ascot and she could be a danger to all. Knock Three Times was second at Nottingham on her racecourse bow and is another who can go close, but a chance is taken on COAT OF RED. The Crisfords' Blue Point filly cost 220,000gns as a yearling and if she lives up to her pedigree, she could prove too good for these.

COMANCHE BRAVE - POWERFUL GLORY - BUCANERO FUERTE

Race Preview: COMANCHE BRAVE was far from outclassed in fifth behind superstar sprinter Ka Ying Rising in Sha Tin last month and there may be more to come from him in the sprinting division. Last season, he was campaigned over longer trips and was placed several times in Group races. British raider Powerful Glory is entitled to maximum respect after winning the Qipco British Champions Sprint Stakes at Ascot last October. Bucanero Fuerte hasn't quite been at his best in two outings this season, but he has plenty of winning form over C&D and ought to be in the thick of the action. Big Gossey loves it here and continues to defy expectations, while Montassib is another to consider.

GSTAAD - DISTANT STORM - THESECRETADVERSARY

Race Preview: Aidan O'Brien's GSTAAD looks very much the one to beat. Last season's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf winner reappeared in the 2000 Guineas and moved clear with the winner before giving best in the closing stages. Distant Storm, who has been chalked up as second favourite behind Gstaad for this assignment, was some eight lengths back in third at Newmarket so it is hard to see that form being overturned, despite the first-time cheekpieces and his solid overall form. Thesecretadversary was behind them in fifth on the Rowley Mile, when keen, but could improve upon that if settling better on home turf. Karl Burke's Alparslan made all in the Greenham at Newbury and is hunting a cheque.

Race Preview: CAUSEWAY has progressed with each run and riding arrangements suggest he is preferred of Aidan O'Brien's trio. The son of Wootton Bassett completed a hat-trick in the Tetrarch here earlier this month and is bred to appreciate the step up to 1m2f. Stablemate Drop Dead Gorgeous didn't enjoy the clearest of passages when third in the Athasi and has plenty of scope for improvement, while South Island and Shosholoza should both progress from their reappearances in the Ballysax at Leopardstown last month.
