RACE 1: GET BEST ODDS WITH ODDSCHECKER MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (2YO ONLY) (FROM CARLISLE RACE 1)

QUEEN OF CHRISTMAS - IN THE BLACK - LOUIS THE FIFTH

Race Preview: Having finished a respectable fifth on her debut at Nottingham, QUEEN OF CHRISTMAS could put her experience to good use. Karl Burke's filly is open to improvement and a breakthrough victory may beckon. Louis The Fifth fetched 215,000 euros last month and market support would be interesting, although a bigger threat may emerge from fellow newcomer In The Black, who is closely related to Group 2 winner El Caballo.

SILESIA - ENHANCING - RUBY MOON

Race Preview: It's difficult to get away from SILESIA, who has posted creditable efforts in defeat on all three outings. A reproduction of her latest third in Hilary Needler at Beverley should make her difficult to beat and she's likely to prove a warm order. Enhancing should find this easier than her opening eighth at Newbury and she may serve the most resistance to the selection, while Ruby Moon is the pick of the newcomers.

Race Preview: Mrs Mole displayed enough promise on her fourth-placed debut at Leicester to suggest that she can land a race of this nature and isn't taken lightly. However, SOCIAL SPIRIT's form looks a tad stronger judged on his latest fifth in the Woodcote at Epsom and he is the one to beat. Ricky Punting is not without a chance, while Platinum Force makes most appeal of the debutants.

Race Preview: RUNSWICK has done little wrong in two handicap outings this season and he could be poised to strike. The three-year-old was denied by only a short head on his most recent outing at Chester and a 2lb rise looks workable. Although unable to justify favouritism at Ripon earlier this month, Barley wasn't disgraced when coming home in third. Tim Easterby's gelding merits consideration, along with Pension Pot and Geo.

Race Preview: This does not appear to be the strongest of races for the grade and that is ideal for ELLUSIVE BUTTERFLY. Karl Burke's filly beat the boys when scoring at this level at Epsom earlier in the month and it would be no surprise to see her defy a 3lb penalty. Golden Palace was third in a similar event at Musselburgh recently and is likely to be in the mix once again, while Albaydaa is progressive and could make an impact in this company.

Race Preview: Leadenhall has to be respected having won two of his last three starts, but marginal preference is for CANVAS. Scott Dixon's gelding was a promising fourth at Newmarket on his seasonal return last month and the four-year-old could build on that effort here. Priapos is another recent winner who has to be considered, while Swift Salian and Mr Lincoln complete the shortlist.

Race Preview: The form of WINE DARK SEA's win at Ascot in May has worked out extremely well and, while this is a competitive handicap, it is hard to oppose Harry Charlton's gelding off just 5lb higher. Alpine Sierra has to be of interest following three wins in May and he cannot be discounted, despite a big step up in grade. The recent York winner Dunkeld Dreamer edges out Gaelic Approach and Trojan Sun to be best of the rest.

A 1lb rise for that success appears to underestimate this progressive filly and she could add another win to her record. That said, the recent Yarmouth maiden winner Shushu has to be noted on her handicap debut and Donna Nook is also considered.

Race Preview: Although disappointing when finishing down the field over 7f at the Curragh last time, better is expected from Gavoo reverting to 6f. Regardless, GO JUST DO IT appeals more easing in class. The son of Kingman travelled strongly up to the 6f mark before his effort gave way in the Irish 2,000 Guineas and this drop back in distance could see him regaining the winning thread. Last-time-out winner Amiata receives plenty of weight from the selection and is feared most.

Race Preview: Oaks fifth CAMEO can resume winning ways. A game winner at Lingfield on her penultimate start, the Aidan O'Brien-trained filly ran well for a long way before weakening late on in the Epsom classic earlier this month. Dropping back in trip here shouldn't be an issue and the daughter of Wootton Bassett looks the one to beat. C&D winner Caught U Sleeping rates the main threat. Having disappointed initially this season, the Noel Meade-trained filly showed marked improvement on her first start over this trip here last month. La Fogata, who was runner-up to Caught U Sleeping on her penultimate start, again ran well when fourth at Navan recently.

Race Preview: Recent Gowran Park second ELUSIVE DUKE can go one better. Following a promising reappearance when midfield at Leopardstown on his previous start, the Mark Molloy-trained gelding stepped up on that effort to take minor honours last time. Sure to be even straighter on this third run of the season, the four-year-old should appreciate the better ground and also has a decent draw close to the running rail. A lightly-raced Palace Pier colt, Oust has reached the frame on his two most recent appearances. He remains open to plenty of improvement at this level and Jack Cleary is a very significant jockey booking. Derry Lad, who has dropped a long way in the handicap, shaped with more promise at Leopardstown last time.

If first-time blinkers bring about the desired improvement, the Ger Lyons-trained gelding should go close. Lightly-raced Night Of Thunder gelding Kalir looks best of the remainder.
