**RACE 1: TALLY HO STUD IRISH EUROPEAN BREEDERS FUND FILLIES MAIDEN (2YO ONLY)**

**CAPE SOUNION - BEAUTIFY - DANCING SAXON**

Race Preview: CAPE SOUNION showed smart ability on debut and can put that experience to good use. Although the well-bred winner of that Naas race was subsequently well beaten at Group 3 level, the selection arguably shaped with more promise as she missed the break, had to be switched to challenge and finished well. She should improve from that run. Beautify is out of Words, who was a Group 3 winner, and is a half-sister to a Listed winner. Dancing Saxon boasts a smart pedigree, while Paris Carver was a 600,000-dollar breeze-up purchase.

**RACE 2: GAIN MARBLE HILL STAKES (GROUP 3) (CLASS 1) (2YO ONLY)**

**ALBERT EINSTEIN - ANDAB - POWER BLUE**

Race Preview: ALBERT EINSTEIN produced a smart effort on his debut recently. From a good family and out of a juvenile Group-placed dam, he was accompanied by his trainer to the start for that Naas introduction and produced a fine performance to wear down the once-raced runner-up. He should continue to progress. Andab is a brother to Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf winner Victoria Road and he too showed high-class potential over C&D earlier this month. He should give the selection a good race. Power Blue wasn't beaten far in Listed company here and also commands attention.

5	MIAMI DESTINATION	Half-sister to Controversial Lady, won three times between 7f and 1m 1f. A winner at 5f on soft ground. Finished 7l behind Lady Iman when fourth of 6 at 50-1 on her latest outing in the Group 3 Coolmore Stud Irish EBF Blackbeard Fillies Sprint Stakes at Naas over 6f (good).
6	SHE'S TOO KOOL	Dam a lightly raced maiden.
7	STONEZILIAN	Half-sister to Clarita, won twice at 7f. Unplaced in both starts. Beaten 11l behind Leblon Queen at 40-1 when 12th of 15 on her latest outing at Roscommon over 7f (good) earlier this month.

**RACE 3: LANWADES STUD STAKES (FILLIES' AND MARES' GROUP 2) (CLASS 1) (4YO PLUS)**

**PORTA FORTUNA - VERA'S SECRET - ONE LOOK**

Race Preview: Four-time Group 1-winning gem PORTA FORTUNA meets some race-fit rivals on seasonal reappearance but can score. She failed by a neck in the English Guineas last May and while well held at November's Breeders Cup, met significant trouble in-running then. Today's race will tee her up for next month's Royal Ascot hat-trick attempt but she has sufficient ability, and form on softening-ground, to score. Late-comer Vera's Secret is now six but seems to be improving and scooted clear to win at Leopardstown last time. One Look, whose rider Billy Lee is bidding for a fifth consecutive win in this race, also landed a Group 3 recently and is ground-versatile.

Well beaten at 50-1 behind Bluestocking when last of 12 on her latest outing in the Group 1 Qatar Prix Vermeille at ParisLongchamp over 1m 4f (soft) in September last year. Having her first run for a new stable today.
4	JANCIS	Successful twice at 7f on good and good - yielding ground. Beaten 1/2l by Madam Celeste when second of 12 at 9-2 on her latest outing at Gowran Park over 1m 1f (good) earlier this month.
5	NAOMI LAPAGLIA	Successful at 7f and 1m on good to soft ground and on the all-weather. Third of 9 behind One Look beaten 2l at 5-2 on her latest outing over this course and distance (good) last month.

**RACE 4: TATTERSALLS GOLD CUP (GROUP 1) (CLASS 1) (4YO PLUS)**

**LOS ANGELES - ANMAAT - WHITE BIRCH**

RACE PREVIEW. Irish Derby winner LOS ANGELES is the pick amongst some middle-distance heavyweights. His classic success came between English Derby and Prix de l'Arc third-placings and while he would prefer 1m4f, today's race is a helpful 110 yards further than when beating White Birch earlier this month. Admittedly well-held by Anmaat in October's British Champion Stakes, the selection was hampered then while the race also came 13 days after his fine Arc effort. Anmaat has progressed with racing and relishes soft ground, but needs to produce his best form to win on seasonal reappearance. Last year's winner White Birch should compete, while Kalpana won October's British Champion Fillies & Mares Stakes but now meets males racing over a slightly inadequate distance.

4	DEEPONE	He has won three times from 7f to 1m on ground varying from good to yielding - soft. Finished 11l behind Dallas Star when fourth of 5 at 11-2 on his latest outing in the Group 3 P.W. McGrath Memorial Ballysax Stakes at Leopardstown over 1m 2f (heavy) in April last year.
5	GHOSTWRITER	He has won three times from 7f to 1m on good to firm and good ground. Finished 2 1/4l behind Soul Rush when fourth of 11 on his latest outing in the Group 1 Race 7 - Dubai Turf Sponsored By DP World - Turf at Meydan over 1m 1f (good) last month.
6	LOS ANGELES	Winner of six races from 1m 1f to 1m 4f on ground varying from good to firm to yielding. Won on his latest outing when 10-11fav here over 1m 2f (good) earlier this month, beating White Birch by a neck.

7	ROYAL RHYME	Winner of five races from 7f to 1m 2f on good to soft and soft ground. Third of 6 behind Sosie beaten 2 1/4l at 9-1 on his latest outing in the Group 1 Prix Ganay at ParisLongchamp over 1m 2f (soft) last month.

**RACE 5: TATTERSALLS IRISH 1,000 GUINEAS (FILLIES' GROUP 1) (CLASS 1) (3YO ONLY)**

**LAKE VICTORIA - FLIGHT - SWELTER**

Race Preview: Almost certain to have improved from Newmarket, LAKE VICTORIA can reverse form with both Flight and Simmering. Having been slow to come to hand this spring, trainer Aidan O'Brien had expressed doubts about the filly being ready in time for the English Guineas. To her credit, the daughter of Frankel ran a huge race, staying on nicely inside the last furlong to finish sixth. Flight, who outran her odds to chase home the winner at Newmarket, should also be better for that first start of the season. The unexposed Swelter and Newmarket third Simmering are also worthy of consideration.
