**RACE 1: ROYAL PIGEON ASSOCIATION HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (3YO ONLY) (FROM WETHERBY RACE 1)**

**CITY OF DREAMS - LIQUID COOLED - ALICE'S INFLUENCE**

Race Preview: CITY OF DREAMS has been competitive on both starts in handicap company and the switch to turf combined with Harry Vigors taking 7lb off gives him an ideal opportunity to gain his first career success. Liquid Cooled won at Newcastle on his first run after a break before running with credit for fourth at Pontefract. He has to be a threat if settling better, while Alice's Influence could benefit from a first-time visor.

**REEM RAK - LAUGHTERINTHERAIN - VALKYRIE STORM**

Race Preview: Galileo Charm has held her form throughout a busy all-weather campaign, and Light The Night Up also has fitness on her side thanks to her C&D fourth. They come up against some interesting handicap debutants, not least REEM RAK, whose best two juvenile efforts came at Newcastle, but there is nothing in her pedigree at least to suggest she won't handle the turf. Laughterintherain took a big step forward to get closest to an odds-on favourite at Lingfield, while Valkyrie Storm and Ten Sixty Six have plenty to recommend them.

**PRINCLING - ERVANI - UNCHARTEDTERRITORY**

Race Preview: PRINCLING showed plenty of ability on both starts as a juvenile and the son of Kingman is expected to be a warm order. The form of his Newmarket second was boosted by the winner following up at Southwell on Thursday and the step up to a mile promises to bring about improvement. Ervani comes from an excellent Aga Khan family and has to command the utmost respect on debut. Unchartedterritory heads the remainder based on his fourth at Ayr in September.

Race Preview: Successful on debut at Sandown before finishing runner-up in a German Group 3, SEA THE STORM is taken to defy a 7lb penalty having switched to William Haggas' yard. Her pedigree suggests the extra couple of furlongs will see her in a better light and a sounder surface shouldn't be an inconvenience. Stable companion Pierian is out of an Irish Oaks winner and is respected along with Nowshesdancing, a winner at Dundalk in January.

Race Preview: Phoenix Moon seems happiest on an artificial surface and stuck her neck out to make a successful start to the campaign at Lingfield. If she can translate that form to turf, she will be the one to beat but ORBITAL CHIME is worth another chance. James Owen's six-year-old wasn't able to show his true colours at Southwell, but went close at Thirsk before that and will relish the return to 6f. Winchurch is most effective at 5f and may be found wanting in the closing stages.

Race Preview: DWINDLING FUNDS was a fine moneyspinner last year, mainly at Ayr, but goes well at this venue too and found only one too strong on his comeback here. Jim Goldie's gelding remains on the same rating and can take full advantage of the drop back to a mile. Stablemate Ayr Poet also enjoyed a good 2025, although he doesn't have the benefit of a recent run. Harry The Rogue almost sprung a Newcastle surprise, with Eazy On The Eye also making the frame on that card, but Swift Salian is feared most following his Pontefract near-miss.

Nad Alshiba Green was runner-up on that occasion and has a 2lb pull with the selection, while better is expected from Smart Vision after being badly hampered on his return at Beverley.

There is more room for manoeuvre with his rating in this sphere, though, and he is preferred to Fast Fred, who confirmed the promise of his comeback second at Newcastle by going one better over C&D. Rising Sky also arrives in winning form, although she must compete from out of the handicap. Eroico is interesting on her first appearance for Martin Todhunter.
