RACE 1: RACINGTV.COM EBF RESTRICTED MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (2YO ONLY) (FROM REDCAR RACE 1)

NOUR - BELLA LUCIA - TIME GLORY

Race Preview: Bella Lucia sets the form standard having made the frame at Beverley on her racecourse bow. Stepping up to six furlongs should be beneficial and she may prove popular. However, NOUR can make a winning start to her racing career. Karl Burke's filly is bred to get further in time but she's evidently been showing speed in the mornings and is more interesting than most. Kevin Ryan's pair Time Glory and One Shot Kodi also require market checks.

CHAMPION LAWMAN - CAPE FEAR - HOSEKI

Race Preview: Cape Fear has been placed in all three starts this season and is one of the likelier winners. Nevertheless, CHAMPION LAWMAN is preferred. Charlie Johnston's colt kept on well into fourth over the mile at Lingfield on his debut and can improve on the back of that effort, not least because a step up in trip should suit. Hoseki completes the shortlist.

CLASSIC ENCOUNTER - DESERT SHADOW - ANDESITE

Race Preview: CLASSIC ENCOUNTER has been plying his trade at a higher level so far this season and can benefit from a drop in class on this occasion. A 1lb ease in the handicap for the five-year-old's most recent Newmarket performance can only aid his cause and a third career victory may beckon. Although Desert Shadow has been underwhelming in two outings this year, he might prove dangerous if a first-time visor helps sharpen him up. Andesite is the pick of the remainder.

Race Preview: The majority probably need to find a bit extra at present and this could prove a suitable opportunity for THORNABY ANNIE to open her account. Adrian Nicholls' filly bounced back to form with a close-up second at Doncaster earlier this month and compensation may await. C&D runner-up Long Shot is unexposed over this trip and is feared most, ahead of Kameko Fever.

CROCUS TIME - KYBER CRYSTAL - LADY BOUQUET

Race Preview: Consistency isn't a strong point for any of these, but CROCUS TIME is on an attractive mark and she earns a narrow vote of confidence. Ron Barr's mare sits 23lb below her peak rating from her younger days and can be expected to fare better than she did on her return at Thirsk 10 days ago. Kyber Crystal should not be underestimated, while Lady Bouquet and Auntie Jo also have reasonable claims on these terms.

Race Preview: BAYRAAT has shown a liking for this venue and has a decent chance of going one place better, having struck the woodwork over C&D on his return to action earlier this month. One Of Our Own is a previous C&D winner that also commands respect, while Let's Go Hugo was second in the corresponding race last year and can be ruled out now that he's 5lb lower.

SYNERGISM - RUSSIAN RUMOUR - MACARI

Race Preview: Russian Rumour is tough, versatile and consistent. However, after making a winning reappearance at Nottingham, the nine-year-old mare must defy another career-high mark and may be vulnerable. By contrast, SYNERGISM proved he can be competitive from his current mark when hitting the frame in a deeper race at Kempton back in October. Effective when fresh, Sir Mark Prescott's gelding can make the most of a drop in class. Macari is the pick of the rest.

SUNSHINE STAR - ASSET - GREEN AREA

Race Preview: SUNSHINE STAR had Asset over three lengths in arrears when they occupied the places in a novices' event at Kempton last October. The selection was patently in need of the run on her reappearance at Sandown last month but that recent spin can give her the edge today. Binknight and Scarlet Letter both need to improve on their debut efforts, so any support for the newcomer Green Area would have to be taken seriously.

Race Preview: TICKETTOTHESTARS broke the maiden tag at Nottingham on her penultimate start. Dropping to the minimum trip didn't appear to suit last time, but she can bounce back returned to 6f. In Denial finished third in behind the Rod Millman-trained filly last time but can get closer on these revised terms. Support in the betting for the likes of Wadirumm and Saeculamation would make them notable each-way options.

Beaten only a short-head by the now 106-rated Needle Match on his debut at Newbury last season, he will be tough to beat if returning at his best. The consistent Ascending Star can follow them home.
