RACE 1: DOWNLOAD THE FAIRPLAY APP APPRENTICE HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS) (FROM BATH RACE 1)

MOON OVER THE SEA - BOHEMIAN BREEZE - MARINAKIS

Race Preview: MOON OVER THE SEA has been knocking on the door on the all-weather of late and he could be poised to strike. A repeat of the seven-year-old's latest third at Wolverhampton may prove sufficient on this switch to turf and he gets the nod over Bohemian Breeze. The son of Galileo arrives on the back of a respectable fourth at Chelmsford and Jude Fernandes claims a handy 7lb. Marinakis is best of the rest.

Race Preview: BALGOWAN was beaten just under a length into third on his return to the fray here a month ago and, if he takes a step forward for that encouraging effort, he might be able to get back to winning ways. Charles Morin is a course scorer who commands plenty of respect on the back of his close-up fifth in that race, while Sapphire Sirocco is next best.

RATING - PARTY ISLAND - RAIN TOWN

Race Preview: Having finished third in a competitive class 4 over 1m4f at Lingfield earlier this month, Party Island must enter calculations in his current form. However, the nine-year-old isn't sure to prove as effective dropping back in trip and RATING shades the vote. Grace Harris' mare reappeared with a third over a mile here recently and any improvement may see her collect. Raintown is also worth a second look easing in class.

Race Preview: TRAVEL AGENT might take a bit of beating here. A C&D winner last summer, Adam Kirby's charge was back in the winning groove at Wolverhampton 10 days ago and the relatively quick turnaround suggests he's bounced out of that race in good nick. Lequinto heads the list of dangers from Maharajas Express, who has an absence to overcome but is a capable type.

Race Preview: Global Success offered enough encouragement on her opening fifth here to suggest that she can make her mark at this level and looks the one to beat. That said, there are some intriguing newcomers on show, with LEUCOTHEA topping the bill. Richard Hannon's filly is a half-sister to juvenile winner Wateen and she may take all the beating if sharing the same ability. Fellow debutant Crown Of Ivy is also noted.

St Hilda performed well on her introduction here in November and is noted, but TICKER TAPE is expected to show marked improvement for her Wolverhampton debut and she edges it for a powerful yard.

Race Preview: SOLAR INVINCIBLE returned to winning ways over this course and distance earlier in the month and a 4lb rise for that success may not be enough to stop him from following up. That said, Comic Strip made a pleasing return when third at Southwell recently and could give the selection plenty to think about. Others to note are Saucy Jane, Angel Numbers and Guernsey Angel.

EL MATADOR - SILVER TRUMPET - PORT ROAD

Race Preview: EL MATADOR wasn't disgraced in some competitive class 2 handicaps towards the end of his three-year-old campaign and a subsequent gelding operation could unlock some improvement. Ralph Beckett's charge makes plenty of appeal dropping in class and market support would increase confidence on this return to action. Silver Trumpet has the benefit of a recent run when fourth at Southwell and he's feared most, ahead of Port Road.

Based on that evidence, the four-year-old merits plenty of respect off the same mark. Her stablemate So Smart was a head behind in fourth that day and is likely to be a big threat once again. Solar Edge is another likely to be in the mix.

Race Preview: Francisco arrives on the back of a fair third at Chelmsford and a 1lb ease in the ratings can only help. However, GLADIADORA supplemented a triumph at Southwell with a narrow defeat at Nottingham and, despite a 2lb rise in the ratings, she might still be well treated. Cooramook returned to form when finishing fourth at Wolverhampton and completes the shortlist.
