Sharp Move looked useful when bolting up at Newcastle back in November and is very much worth considering, despite having to concede weight-for-age and a winner's penalty. Hello Friend has occupied the runner-up spot twice already and looks sure to be on the premises. So might Turret, who took a huge leap forward to score at Carlisle.

Race Preview: A wide draw has done PRINCE OF CALYPSO no favours but, even so, he might still be worth chancing. Ed Bethell's bay took a backward step at Thirsk earlier this month, but it's likely he'll do better over middle distances now handicapping and his debut third offers some suggestion that an opening mark of 70 might be lenient. Fans Favourite reverts to the all-weather having notched up a brace of wins at Lingfield and Ayr. He's another 7lb higher, though, and Tinsel could emerge as the biggest threat.

Jim Goldie's gelding was well held in all three of his qualifying runs last year, but returns on the back of wind surgery. He's related to some smart types and may prove much better than an opening mark of 51.
