**RACE 1: WEATHERBYS RACING BANK NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (3YO TO 4YO) (FROM EPSOM DOWNS RACE 1)**

**RUNMAN - VITALITY - GET OUTTA HERE**

Race Preview: Vitality ran better than her odds suggested she would when third on her introduction at Southwell and there is likely to be plenty more under the bonnet. Even so, it's hard to ignore the claims of RUNMAN. The son of Frankel is a half-brother to the high-class Running Lion and it would be no surprise to see him build on his smart juvenile success at Salisbury in October. Get Outta Here is the pick of the remainder.

**FISTRAL BEACH - REENIE'S DREAM - ENGLISH LADY**

Race Preview: Reenie's Dream showed more when fourth over track and trip on her latest outing and could go well from an unchanged mark, especially because she is berthed well in stall one. However, FISTRAL BEACH continued her fine form when only beaten a length into second at Wolverhampton latest and is fancied to make it two wins from her last five appearances. Of the remainder, English Lady makes the most appeal.

**SAXON STREET - NEW ZEALAND - BALZAC**

Race Preview: New Zealand was certainly the best of these as a juvenile, with the pick of his efforts arguably coming when fifth in the Criterium International at Saint-Cloud. He is bound to attract plenty of support, but the one who appeals most is SAXON STREET. The Gosdens' colt left the impression he would come on bundles for his debut victory over a mile at Chelmsford in December. His dam is a sister to Group 3 winner Raheen House so the step up in trip should be heavily in his favour. Balzac won well at Kempton on his return, although that form has already taken a few knocks.

Race Preview: Invitorio dug in gamely to score over track and trip earlier in the month and holds an obvious chance again, but it may pay to side with MAN ON A MISSION. The seven-year-old was just touched off over C&D on Saturday so providing he copes with this quick turnaround, he could prove hard to beat. Nad Alshiba Snow can't be underestimated either.

Race Preview: Rathgar was given a smart ride by Tom Marquand to hold on by a neck at Newbury recently and he should mount a bold bid, despite having a 4lb higher mark to contend with. Sallaal remains unexposed for his age and is one to keep a close eye on, but the vote goes to AUREL. Ralph Beckett's charge was thrown in at the deep end when seventh in the Golden Gates at Royal Ascot last June and will find this easier on his return to the fray.

**SOCIETY KISS - REIGNING QUEEN - SHES GOT A BROTHER**

Race Preview: SOCIETY KISS struck on her introduction before running with credit in the Queen Mary at Royal Ascot last term, and the fact she was only a 7/1 shot that day suggests there should be more to come. This is her first start for the John Mackie yard and an official rating of 86 very much sets the standard. Reigning Queen would be of interest if the market speaks in her favour, whilst C&D debut scorer Shes Got A Brother is next best.

**TOPTEAM - ASGARD'S CAPTAIN - SING US A SONG**

Race Preview: Asgard's Captain probably doesn't have much wiggle room from his current handicap mark, but he won this 12 months ago and arrives following a fair spell out in Dubai. TOPTEAM was progressive as a three-year-old last term, though, and showed the benefit of a gelding operation when scoring on his return at Kempton. The son of Oasis Dream is three from six on the grass and could have lots more to offer this season. That might also be said for Sing Us A Song, who was last seen winning at Haydock.

John Butler's charge seems to really like this track and won over C&D last time giving the impression there is more to come. Tupero proved a breakthrough Newcastle triumph was no fluke when occupying the runner-up berth at Catterick and he heads the list of dangers from Eagles Whistle.

Switching to turf shouldn't be an issue, nor should an opening mark of 82, but MONTAGUE MENACE might be better treated of the pair. Andrew Balding's charge struggled on soft ground last term, but returned to score on the all-weather at Lingfield recently. Into handicaps on a better surface, he could find further progress. On Message is also noted.

Race Preview: ANCIENT STATE made the perfect start for the Adam Kirby stable when successful at Southwell on his most recent start and even though a 6lb higher figure makes life tougher, he remains the one to beat. Mick's Spirit went in by half a length over C&D last month and is likely to be on the premises, while Aleppo Pepper is another to watch out for.

The five-year-old is only 1lb above last year's winning mark and is fancied to repeat the dose. Previous course winner Mr Baloo merits respect having struck at Lingfield a fortnight ago, and don't rule out the class-dropping Knights Gold.
