RACE 1: GET RACEDAY READY HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS) (FROM YARMOUTH RACE 1)

HIBERNATE - MERAPI - TWILIGHT GUEST

Race Preview: Dropping in class and trip could be a good combination for HIBERNATE, who is back on a winning mark and won't need to find much to stamp his authority under top weight. Merapi is feared the most following a respectable second over 1m here last time. Michael Keady's filly is still a maiden after 12 previous attempts but is too well handicapped to dismiss. Twilight Guest runs off 5lb below his last successful rating and is another to consider.

Race Preview: SEATHEGULLS was fancied for the Brocklesby and showed up well for a long way before fading into seventh. He should know more about what is expected of him and is marginally preferred to El Lambo, who displayed some ability at Newbury. Archie Watson's two-year-olds have hit the ground running so Kodi Bear colt Alpe d'Huez tops the list of interesting newcomers.

FASHION PEOPLE - NIGHT SHINING - BAANDEE

Race Preview: FASHION PEOPLE was a well-backed favourite when successfully introduced at Newcastle on her sole start as juvenile. There was enough in the performance to suggest the daughter of Mehmas is a fair prospect and is a logical choice, despite a 7lb penalty. The well-bred Night Shining, who cost 475,000gns as a yearling, is entitled to be wiser on just her second career start. George Boughey's filly has bags of scope and is feared more than the consistent Baandee on that basis.

Race Preview: POETIC JACK hasn't managed to get his head in front for a while, but it's not through lack of trying and he was acquitting himself well at Chelmsford prior to a fair Southwell fourth on his return to handicap company. The assessor has dropped him another 1lb and he really should be able to capitalise. Southbank has also maintained a solid level of consistency so far this year and won't be far away. Walking On Clouds was fancied to perform better than he did at Wolverhampton, but might have found his current level now.

Race Preview: Venetian Lion is related to several winners and the well-bred newcomer may be the pick of the William Haggas-trained pair, while Alpine Culture and Euston Hall have shown some promise and merit close inspection in the betting market. However, slender preference is for FAHIDI, who debuted in a Sandown maiden that worked out well, before he finished a respectable third at Haydock despite running green. Sure to be wiser, Andrew Balding's colt can get off the mark with another step forward.

Race Preview: Mintana is likely to give her supporters a run for their money from on or near the pace, but it's possible that she's most effective over 7f these days. It might be the other way round for PORFIN, whose last two outings have come at that trip but he was in better form over this distance previously and struck under today's jockey over C&D as recently as January. Harry Brown was back in third on that occasion, but is better off at the weights so must be feared.

Race Preview: It's hard to look past ALICE DE CLARE, who made her way through the field to just be denied on her handicap debut at Bath, finishing nicely clear of the third. James Fanshawe's filly competes off the same mark and as long as this quick turnaround doesn't inconvenience her, she will prove hard to beat. Sports Day finished a close third over a mile here earlier in the month and may improve for this step up in trip. Grindleton is another to consider.

Race Preview: Desdemona failed in her bid to complete a three-timer when only sixth over 6f here last month, but both of her previous victories came over this distance so there will be plenty who give her another chance. C&D scorer Wedgewood may also have a say, but TUSCAN POINT finished over three lengths clear of the third when hitting the woodwork at Catterick and with the Adam Kirby yard in fine order, he looks the one to side with.

Race Preview: Golden Horse got off the mark over an extended mile at Hamilton prior to only managing sixth under a penalty at Newmarket next time. His opening figure of 79 is unlikely to be beyond him so he has to be respected, but a chance can be taken on CLOUDS HILL. Charlie Johnston's charge shed his maiden tag at Newcastle in November, shaping as if this step up in distance would bring out improvement, and he looks the one to side with. A Major Payne is the pick of the remainder.

Moonshine is another on an upward curve on the evidence of her novice win at Kempton. She makes her handicap debut with a shout, while You'll Think Of Me and Harlequin Angel are also of interest.
