Race Preview: KODI LION's second at Haydock can be marked up as he failed to get a clear run. He has to be of interest with William Buick taking over the reins and is fancied to go one better. The progressive Woroodd landed the odds in novice company at Haydock back in May and is one to note on her handicap debut. Nothing went right for Headmaster at Glorious Goodwood on his handicap bow, but it's too soon to write him off.
