RACE 1: CORAL CHESTERFIELD CUP HANDICAP (CLASS 2) (4YO PLUS)

STAY WELL - WADACRE GOMEZ - BYSTANDER

Race Preview: Wadacre Gomez has struck on two of his last three starts on the all-weather and his latest victory showed that he is still ahead of the handicapper. With William Buick booked, he has to be taken seriously, but a chance can be taken on STAY WELL. Hughie Morrison's six-year-old finished third behind Wadacre Gomez before filling the runner-up spot behind Enfjaar next time, but he is much better off at the weights with both and is taken to go close. Bystander was a smart winner of a hot handicap at Newcastle last time and is another to watch out for.

2	ENFJAAR	He has won four times from 7f to 1m 2f on good to soft ground and on the all-weather. A winner at 15-2 at York over 1m 2f (good to soft) on his latest outing earlier this month, beating Botanical by 1 3/4l. Has also won at Chelmsford City this season.
3	OUZO	Winner of seven races from 7f to 1m 1f on good and soft ground. Beaten 10l behind Israr at 33-1 when seventh of 15 on his latest outing at Ascot over 1m 2f (good to firm) last month.
4	TEUMESSIAS FOX	He has won four times from 1m 2f to 1m 4f on good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 10l behind Passion And Glory at 22-1 when 10th of 13 on his latest outing at Ascot over 1m 4f (good) earlier this month.
5	MAX MAYHEM	He has won four times from 1m 2f to 1m 3f on good and yielding ground and on the all-weather. Finished 17l behind Persica when fourth of 10 at 25-1 on his latest outing at Sandown over 1m 2f (soft) earlier this month.
6	REAL GAIN	He has won three times from 1m to 1m 2f on good to firm ground and on the all-weather. Well beaten at 9-1 behind Wild Tiger when 28th of 29 on his latest outing at Ascot over 1m (good to firm) last month.
7	TRACK OF TIME	He has won three times from 1m to 1m 2f on good ground and on the all-weather. Finished 17l behind Persica when fifth of 10 at 33-1 on his latest outing at Sandown over 1m 2f (soft) earlier this month.
8	DUAL IDENTITY	Winner of five races from 1m to 1m 2f on good and soft ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 5l behind Enfjaar at 22-1 when 9th of 20 on his latest outing at York over 1m 2f (good to soft) earlier this month.
9	AERION POWER	He has won four times from 7f to 1m on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 11l behind Wild Tiger at 33-1 when 19th of 29 on his latest outing at Ascot over 1m (good to firm) last month.
10	KILLYBEGS WARRIOR	He has won three times from 7f to 1m 2f on good to firm and good ground. Well beaten at 66-1 behind Enfjaar when last of 20 on his latest outing at York over 1m 2f (good to soft) earlier this month.
11	TAKE HEART	Successful at 1m and 1m 2f on good - yielding ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 4 1/2l behind Enfjaar at 16-1 when eighth of 20 on his latest outing at York over 1m 2f (good to soft) earlier this month.
12	TONY MONTANA	He has won three times at 1m 2f on good ground. Third of 20 behind Enfjaar beaten 2 1/4l at 28-1 on his latest outing at York over 1m 2f (good to soft) earlier this month. Has won at Windsor and Chester this season.

13	WADACRE GOMEZ	Winner of seven races from 1m 1f to 1m 2f on the all-weather. A winner at 6-1 at Chelmsford City over 1m 2f on his latest outing earlier this month, beating Mighty Nebula by 1 1/2l.
14	BYSTANDER	He has won three times from 1m to 1m 2f on the all-weather. A winner at 7-2 at Newcastle over 1m 2f on his latest outing last month, beating Forceful Speed by 1 1/4l.
15	CRACK SHOT	He has won three times at 1m on good to firm and good ground. Beaten 9l behind Enfjaar at 9-1 when 14th of 20 on his latest outing at York over 1m 2f (good to soft) earlier this month.
16	KING'S CODE	Winner of seven races from 7f to 1m 1f on ground varying from firm to heavy and on the all-weather. Beaten 8l behind Passion And Glory at 16-1 when 9th of 13 on his latest outing at Ascot over 1m 4f (good) earlier this month.
17	STAY WELL	He has won three times from 1m 2f to 1m 4f on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather, but last win was over two years ago. Beaten 1 3/4l by Enfjaar when second of 8 at 7-2 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 1m 2f last month.
18	LOYAL TOUCH	He has won four times from 1m to 1m 2f on good and soft ground and on the all-weather. Beaten 11l behind Iron Lion at 15-2 when seventh of 9 on his latest outing at Ripon over 1m 4f (good) earlier this month. Has won at Chester and Newcastle this season.

RACE 2: HKJC WORLD POOL VINTAGE STAKES (GROUP 2) (CLASS 1) (2YO ONLY)

AOMORI CITY - THE PARTHENON - ELECTROLYTE

Race Preview: The Parthenon has some fancy entries for the end of his campaign this year so must be held in high regard by his powerful connections and he did what was required to shed his maiden tag at Gowran Park. However, AOMORI CITY has a lot more substance to his form after finishing third in a Group 2 at Newmarket earlier in the month. Charlie Appleby's juvenile makes only his third career start and he could find the improvement needed going up in trip. Electrolyte (second) beat Cool Hoof Luke (fourth) in the Coventry and is another to note.

3	ARABIAN SUN	Foaled 4 Feb. Half-brother to Gidwa, won four times at 6f and 7f. A winner at 10-3 at Salisbury over 6f (good to firm) on his latest outing last month, beating Stratusnine by 1/2l.
4	COOL HOOF LUKE	Foaled 29 Mar. Dam a lightly raced maiden. A winner at 6f on the all-weather. Finished 3/4l behind Rashabar when fourth of 22 at 40-1 on his latest outing in the Group 2 Coventry Stakes at Ascot over 6f (good to firm) last month.

RACE 3: HKJC WORLD POOL LENNOX STAKES (GROUP 2) (CLASS 1) (3YO PLUS)

NOBLE DYNASTY - KINROSS - AUDIENCE

Race Preview: Kinross has taken two of the last three renewals of this contest and has struck at Group 2 level five times, but his form this year isn't as strong and he looks worth taking on with NOBLE DYNASTY. The son of Dubawi beat English Oak (second) by two lengths at Newmarket in May and took another step forward when scoring in the Criterion next time. If he can run to the level of those efforts, then he could prove hard to beat. Audience was a surprise winner of the Lockinge in May and wasn't disgraced when fifth in the Queen Anne.

RACE 4: AL SHAQAB GOODWOOD CUP STAKES (GROUP 1) (BRITISH CHAMPIONS SERIES) (CLASS 1) (3YO PLUS)

KYPRIOS - SWEET WILLIAM - COLTRANE

Race Preview: Ascot Gold Cup hero KYPRIOS had an epic battle with Stradivarius when he won this in 2022 and has thrived at the top table in this division ever since. While the son of Galileo didn't get the chance to defend his crown here 12 months ago, he can make up for lost time by cementing his authority over some old rivals. Sweet William was six lengths behind the selection in the Gold Cup but has a feasible chance of getting closer over this shorter trip. Coltrane was third in last year's renewal and is another to bear in mind.
