RACE 1: MELISSA, ARABELLA AND ORIANA HAWTHORNE HANDICAP (CLASS 6) (4YO PLUS) (FROM MUSSELBURGH RACE 1)

PERFIDIA - APPROACHING DAWN - MAYOR OF MAGHERA

Race Preview: PERFIDIA made all of the running to land an apprentice contest under Jack Dickson at Nottingham on Thursday and is likely to be a tough nut to crack given that he escapes a penalty and his rider can claim 7lb this time. A slow start didn't help Approaching Dawn's cause last time but he still ran creditably in third and might prove to be a bigger threat than Mayor Of Maghera.

However, HEFFERNAN KINGDOM was able to build on a fairly pleasing racecourse bow at Thirsk when finishing third at Wetherby, and any further progress might be enough. Bear Lee wasn't disgraced at Redcar and is likely to improve.

Race Preview: Pontefract winner HAAYIMM bumped into the subsequent Britannia Stakes sixth Conclave at Hamilton on his latest outing and, although not obviously well treated off an opening mark of 95, he's still open to bags of improvement and might be up to the task. High Degree continues to churn out creditable performances and is likely to give his running again, as should Pandemonium, who went agonisingly close over C&D last time.

Versatile in regards to trip, the eight-year-old had been in great form in classified stakes company and was up to the task when sent back handicapping here last week. A 4lb penalty is unlikely to anchor him and he can continue on his merry way. Is She Now and Sophiesticate are the ones expected to put up the most resistance.
