RACE 1: BETWAY HANDICAP (GBBPLUS RACE) (CLASS 2) (4YO PLUS) (FROM CARLISLE RACE 1)

OPPORTUNITY - GHAIYYA - TOPTEAM

Race Preview: Ghaiyya has posted two fine efforts so far this year, most recently filling the runner-up spot at Hamilton, and she has to be taken seriously. Topteam bounced back to form when only beaten a length into second at Newmarket and is noted, but OPPORTUNITY might be the one. William Haggas' charge was gelded over the winter and returned with a creditable third at Ascot. This represents just his second start in handicap company and he is likely to have more to offer.

SIR WILLIAM - MAFTING - URBAN GLIMPSE

Race Preview: SIR WILLIAM produced a much better display when filling the runner-up spot over an extended 1m3f at Windsor recently and goes off the same mark. The application of first-time cheekpieces might eke out the improvement required for him to go one better. Mafting was successful the last time he was seen over this trip at Redcar three starts ago and needs to be taken seriously, while Urban Glimpse is another to watch out for.

REALIGN - NATIVE HONEY - WILD CLARY

Race Preview: Native Honey returned to winning ways over 7f at Ayr 10 days ago and remains of interest, despite this drop back in distance. Wild Clary was just touched off at Ripon last month and is bound to mount a bold bid, but the vote goes to REALIGN. The son of Blue Point finished a disappointing ninth at Newmarket on his return, but he now takes a drop in grade and the application of first-time cheekpieces might see him in a different light.

The Can Can Queen possesses a similar profile after getting off the mark at Ripon, but the one who appeals most is CRYSTAL QUEEN. Despite pulling hard throughout, the daughter of Cotai Glory shaped with bundles of promise when second on her introduction at Ayr and she could take a step forward to strike.

Race Preview: STARLUST, the 2024 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint hero, makes his return and is tough to oppose in this company. Ralph Beckett's speedster finished a highly creditable fourth in the King Charles III at Royal Ascot last summer and should prove a cut above these. Azure Angel sprung a 22/1 surprise when victorious at Bath and she isn't one to take lightly, while Windsor handicap winner Redorange is another to watch.

Arapaho Gold beat a subsequent winner by over two lengths at Thirsk and has to be considered along with Big Cigar, who struck at the first time of asking at Newcastle.

Race Preview: ESTRANGE is a mare of the highest order and ran right away from her rivals when this was staged at its usual home of Haydock 12 months ago. She went on to claim Lancashire Oaks glory before occupying the runner-up berth in a couple of Group 1 events and really does look a class apart. Her fondness for cut in the ground is well documented so if conditions really are too quick, Owen Burrows will be waiting to pounce with Waardah and Azaniya. Sharpen is worth a look on her first appearance for George Boughey.

CREST OF FIRE - PRINCLING - LANGSTONE

Race Preview: This race often involves Group horses masquerading as handicappers and the one with the obvious potential this year is Princling, who built on his two seconds as a juvenile when justifying skinny odds on his Wetherby return. Fellow handicap debutant Langstone has won twice this year, and Laureate Crown is also on a hat-trick after supplementing a Wolverhampton triumph at Sandown. CREST OF FIRE was only two lengths behind him in fourth on considerably worse terms at Ascot last summer, though, and having boosted his confidence with a bloodless Southwell success, he can improve past his rival to land the spoils.

A narrow C&D defeat is sandwiched in between two lacklustre efforts this term but perhaps he will do better back over track and trip, especially given his handy berth. Frankies Dream merits respect having stepped forward from a below-par seasonal return. Others to note include Billyb, Physique and Bell Shot.
