RACE 1: **BETWRIGHT BET THE WRIGHT WAY APPRENTICE HANDICAP (CLASS 5) (3YO PLUS) (FROM BATH RACE 1)**

SAN FRANCISCO BAY - STIPULATION - DRAGONFLAME

Race Preview: The hat-trick seeking Stipulation is sure to have his supporters after his Wolverhampton success earlier in the month, but the vote goes to SAN FRANCISCO BAY. Henry Candy's charge finished just under three lengths clear of the third at Lingfield at the start of the month and is just 1lb higher. The six-year-old remains on a workable rating and looks the one to beat. Dragonflame isn't ruled out either.

HARLINGTON - HICCUPS - ELECTRIC BASS

Race Preview: HARLINGTON struck by just under two lengths at Wolverhampton recently and the handicapper may have been kind to only put him up 3lb. The Joe Tickle-trained four-year-old may improve for this extra furlong and can complete a double. Hiccups occupied the runner-up berth in this grade at Redcar and is likely to be thereabouts again. Of the remainder, Electric Bass makes the most appeal.

Race Preview: ON A VESPA failed to supplement her Ffos Las success when well beaten at Windsor last time, but she didn't enjoy the softer conditions that day and could bounce back to score. Spirit Of Breeze went in by a length over 7f at Salisbury last month and it's hard to ignore his claims. Moonlight Bomb runs off a career-low rating and would be foolish to dismiss.

Baynoona finally opened her account when scoring with a bit to spare here last time. She could feature once again, while Thiscouldbefun and Latin are others capable of having a say in proceedings.

Race Preview: ITEM will likely prove a warm order off the back of an impressive debut victory over 7f at Kempton. A subsequent entry in next month's Group 1 Futurity Stakes suggests big things are expected of the Frankel progeny and this extra yardage should hold no fears for Andrew Balding's charge. Blue Courvoisier also made a winning debut when successful at Leicester and will likely prove the main danger, ahead of Newmarket fourth Annastarzy.

STAR CHORUS won on good to firm at Chepstow during the summer and, having landed a competitive sprint in fine style at Southwell a week ago, the son of Mehmas gets the vote to defy a 6lb penalty and go in again.

Race Preview: HELLO GOODBYE has filled the runner-up spot on two of her three starts so far, most recently over 7f at Southwell, and this drop in trip looks a good move. With Silvestre De Sousa booked, she will prove hard to beat. Eliza Bennet was beaten by her sole rival at Kempton at the start of the month, but has to be respected. Any market confidence behind newcomer Polka would be interesting.

GOLDEN CONQUEROR - SKIATHOS - MR WONKA

Race Preview: Greenness blighted GOLDEN CONQUEROR's debut run at Kempton, where he was slightly bumped at the start before being hampered on the bend and in danger of finishing tailed off. However, the son of Starspangledbanner, a 200,000gns breeze-up purchase, caught the eye when rallying towards the finish. He did well to finish fifth and should be a great deal wiser. Skiathos has to be of interest debuting for a yard with an excellent strike-rate with juveniles. Mr Wonka is the pick of the rest.
