

RACE 1 3:00 AM | USD1,000,000 | **DEL MAR** | 1408m

3	VAHVA	Strong 2nd over 1207m G2 on 5 October; class performer with strong late finish, ideally drawn to stalk and strike.
6	SWEET AZTECA	Seven-time winner with blazing early speed; danger if unchallenged, distance stretch offers optimism.
4	TAMARA	Win over 1308m G3 on 5 October shows proven class; unbeaten at Del Mar and still improving sharply.
7	HAULIN ICE	Strong 1408m G3 win on 21 September; ten-time winner in top form, consistent and tough on-pace type.

RACE 2 3:41 AM | USD1,000,000 | **DEL MAR** | 1006m

1	MOTORIOUS	Class turf sprinter with a superb Del Mar record (5 starts: 4 wins, 1 second). Won this track-and-trip event last year and arrives in identical form. Reliable, consistent, and perfectly drawn in Barrier 1.
2	REEF RUNNER	Strong 5 wins from 15 starts at the distance and adaptable on firm ground. The main danger if he finds clear running late.
4	KHADEM	European veteran who beat high-class fields at Keeneland last start. Although nine years old, his tactical speed and experience make him a legitimate podium threat.
3	ARIZONA BLAZE	Progressive 3YO sprinter and multiple European stakes winner who handles good or soft going. Might find this sharper 1000m trip short, but his class can carry him into the frame.

RACE 3 4:21 AM | USD2,000,000 | **DEL MAR** | 1207m

12	STRAIGHT NO CHASER	Eight wins from 15 starts, including this race last year. Drawn wide but thrives when rolling forward; if he breaks cleanly, he's the benchmark again.
1	KOPION	Main danger from the inside draw. Consistent mare with blistering early speed. Multiple G1 winner around 1400m but versatile enough to handle this 1200m trip.
6	DR. VENKMAN	In top form; won the Pat O'Brien Stakes and loves Del Mar, where he's won four out of six starts. If pace collapses, he'll be right there late.
8	NAKATOMI	Fresh off a G1 win in the Phoenix Stakes at Keeneland, proven traveler with good tactical speed. Slightly better suited by a hot tempo; must not get buried from midfield.

RACE 4 5:01 AM | USD2,000,000 | **DEL MAR** | 1811m

1	NITROGEN	Class 3YO filly with a six-win career including the G1 Alabama Stakes. Drawn perfectly in Barrier 1 and has won over similar trip; sets the standard for this field.
3	CLICQUOT	Lightly-raced rising star (4 wins from 5). Flavien Prat takes the ride, and she should get a soft run from gate 3 — big threat if she handles the step up to G1.
4	SCYLLA	The seasoned Juddmonte mare has proven herself against elite company. Ultra-consistent, strong finish guarantees she'll be in the mix if the leaders overdo it early.
8	SEISMIC BEAUTY	Bob Baffert's local hope and multiple stakes winner. Excellent Del Mar record and has early speed to control tempo from the outside draw.

RACE 5 5:41 AM | USD5,000,000 | **DEL MAR** | 2414m

1	REBEL'S ROMANCE	Eight wins from his last 12 and unbeaten at this course and trip. Drawn 1 for the ideal rails-run stalking position; still the one they all have to beat.
8	MINNIE HAUK	Her record (11 starts: 8 wins, 3 seconds) speaks for itself. Handles any ground and profiles as the best 3YO staying filly in training.
2	GOLIATH	Winner of Germany's Grosser Preis von Baden (G1), showing stamina and determination. Drawn 2 to get a perfect trip right behind the leaders; a genuine Top 3 contender if the pace is even.
10	EL CORDOBES	Top 3 in recent 2414m Condition races, proven at distance; consistent and adaptable, though may find his stablemate too strong late.

RACE 6 6:25 AM | USD7,000,000 | **DEL MAR** | 2012m

7	SIERRA LEONE	Last year's Classic winner who remains ultra-consistent (13: 5-5-3). Drawn well in Gate 7 to sit just off the pace and launch late as he did in 2024.
5	FOREVER YOUNG	Globetrotting Japanese star with an incredible record (10 starts: 7 wins, 3 placings). Strong 3rd in this race last year, major player again if track rides firm.
1	FIERCENESS	Pacific Classic winner, drawn the rail to dictate tempo again. If he gets an easy lead, he can take catching.
8	MINDFRAME	Lightly raced and already a G1 winner. Has tactical speed to stay close and the turn of foot to fill the frame if the pace suits.

RACE 7 7:05 AM | USD2,000,000 | **DEL MAR** | 1609m

11	RHETORICAL	Unbeaten turf miler in 2025 (5 wins from 6) and continues to improve. Drawn wide but possesses a versatile running style and explosive turn of foot, hard to go past on current form.
7	JOHANNES	Proven Del Mar performer, runner-up in this race last year and still thriving (15: 9-1-1). Loves firm ground and has home-track advantage to go one better.
2	NOTABLE SPEECH	Fresh off a strong win over 1609m in September; has been in the money in his last three elite starts and draws well in Gate 2 for a rails run.
8	FORMIDABLE MAN	Perfect record at Del Mar (6 from 6); tough California local with a relentless finish who must be respected in home conditions.

RACE 8 7:45 AM | USD1,000,000 | **DEL MAR** | 1609m

3	NYSOS	Class act and unbeaten specialist around this trip (6 starts: 5 wins). Baffert-trained and perfectly drawn to control the pace, clearly the one to beat.
6	FULL SERRANO	Defending Dirt Mile champion and course specialist (8 starts at Del Mar: 6 wins, 2 seconds). Arrives in superb form after a runaway 7.25-length win here in September; if pace is strong, he'll power over them late.
7	CITIZEN BULL	Talented 3YO with impressive record (9 starts: 5 wins). Keeps improving and is drawn for a stalking run behind leaders.
4	MYSTIK DAN	Strong win last start; may find these shorter trips a bit sharp but will be finishing off strongly.

RACE 9 8:25 AM | USD2,000,000 | **DEL MAR** | 2213m

13	SHE FEELS PRETTY	Classy mare in career-best form (12 starts: 8-2-2) with brilliant turn of foot and Velazquez sticks. Draw a touch wide but simply the one to beat.
5	GEZORA	French Group 1 winner of the Prix de Diane and arrives off a solid Arc run behind elite company. Big chance if she brings that European class form west.
2	STELLIFY	Lightly-raced Justify filly (6 starts: 4-1-1) who has won four straight. Powerful front-running style and draws beautifully in Gate 2 to dictate terms.
12	BELLEZZA	Two from two at this distance and should get a soft trail midfield. A must-include for first fours and multis.
