UNDERSTANDING BET TYPES

BET TYPE:

ASIAN HANDICAP/ASIAN HANDICAP LIVE

This bet type eliminates the chances of a draw and provides customers with near equal chance of winning for both teams.

How to Play

Here are some scenarios based on the handicap given:

Example 1



Team A the favourite is given a handicap of -0.25.

It means that your bet will be split equally between 0 and -0.5.


If you've placed a bet of \$10 on Team A to win, \$5 will be placed on Team A at 0 and the remaining \$5 will be placed at -0.5.

In order for you to win the bet, Team A must win the game.

If the game ends in a draw, you'll receive half of your stakes back.

If Team A loses the match, you'll lose your stakes.

Example 2



Team B the underdog is given a handicap of +0.75. It means that your bet will be split equally between +0.5 and +1. If you've placed a bet of \$10 on Team B to win, \$5 will be placed on Team B at +0.5 and the remaining \$5 will be placed at +1. For you to win the bet, Team B must win or draw the game.

If Team B loses by one goal, you'll receive half of your stakes back.

If Team B loses by two or more goals, you'll lose your stakes.

Example 3



Team B the favourite starts off with a handicap of -1.

If you've placed \$10 on Team C to win, this means that Team B must win the game by two goals or more for you to win the bet.

If Team B wins by one goal, you'll receive your stakes back.

If Team B draws or loses, you'll lose your stakes.
