Temporary Closure of Livewire Outlets at China Square and Singapore Pools Building

Singapore, 22 June 2021 - Singapore Pools has been notified by Ministry of Health (MOH) that a person with COVID-19 had visited Livewire at China Square on 17 to 19 June 2021. From our venue booking records, this person may have visited Livewire at Singapore Pools Building on 15 and 16 June 2021 as well.

As a precaution, Singapore Pools has closed both venues temporarily with immediate effect, until further notice. Deep cleaning and disinfection will be carried out today.

All employees who were on duty at the two Livewires during the stated days have been advised to stay home. We are working closely with MOH to facilitate the next actions including swab tests for these employees.

Singapore Pools is providing full assistance to MOH in its contact tracing efforts. We will take guidance from MOH on any further action that is needed.
